I would like to propose adopting the following textbook and resource material for teaching the Human Anatomy and Physiology class in the 2010-2011 school year. I have chosen the Martini/Bartholomew Essentials of Anatomy and Physiology 5th edition. This text is a high school binding that is one of the most widely used A &P texts. Moreover it is the simpler version of the college text by the same author that is used in most colleges for nursing and health care programs. I have also considered the Essentials of Human A&P by Marieb, Human A&P by Marieb and the Fundamentals of A&P by Martini and Nath. The later two are both more difficult texts that are more appropriate for AP level or college level while the Marieb Essentials text does not have some of the critical features compared with the Martini text. The Martini Essentials has vocabulary charts and sections to help the students learn the Latin roots and study the clinical terms. In addition it has clinical notes and excerpts to relate the material to professional fields and experiences. Moreover, I believe the figures and diagrams are superior in the Martini text. The price of both of the Essential texts was the same. However, I would like to get the Marieb Lab manual as Martini does not author one. I will need a class set of 25 student texts.
