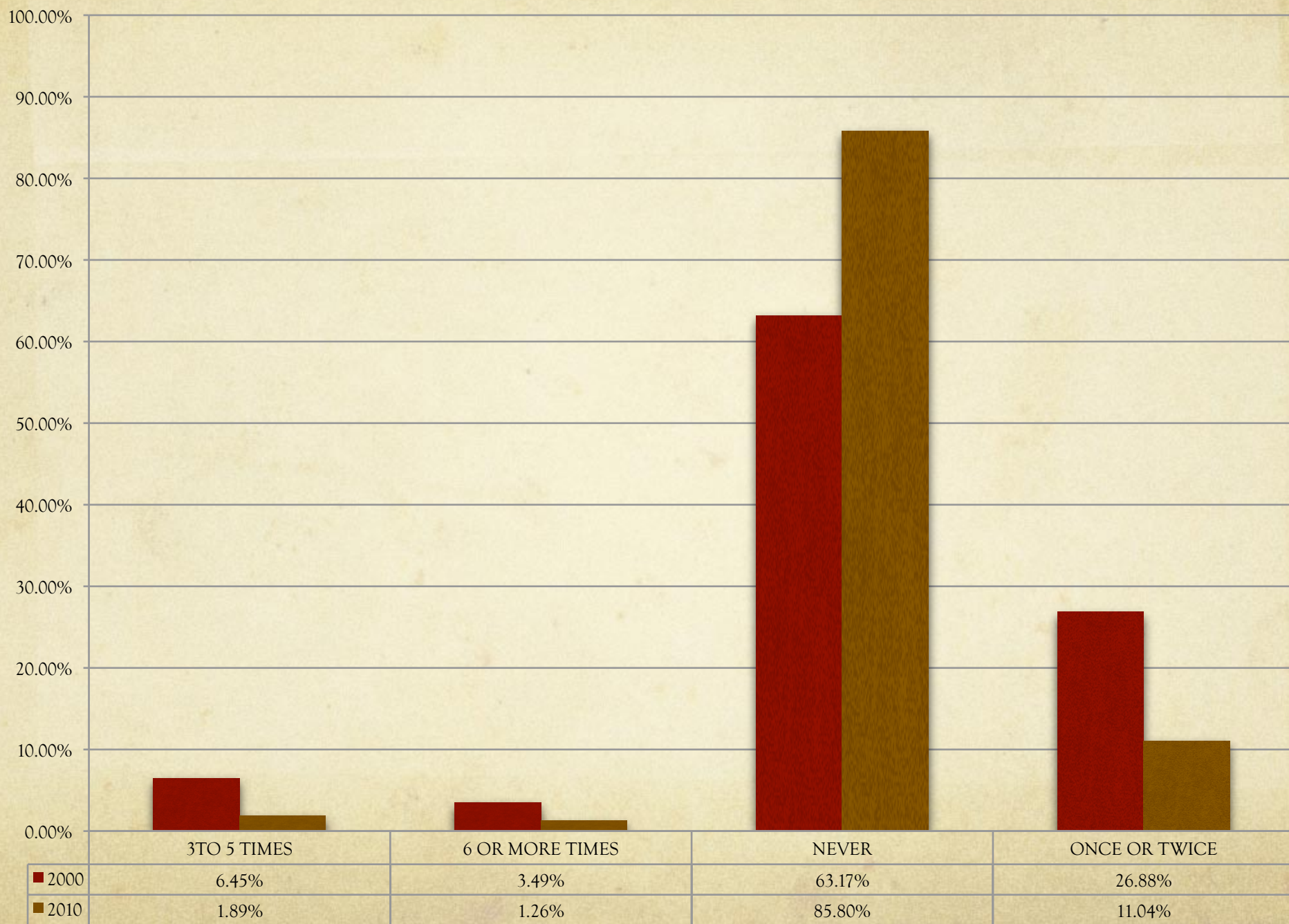
# About the Survey

    - Aggregated results



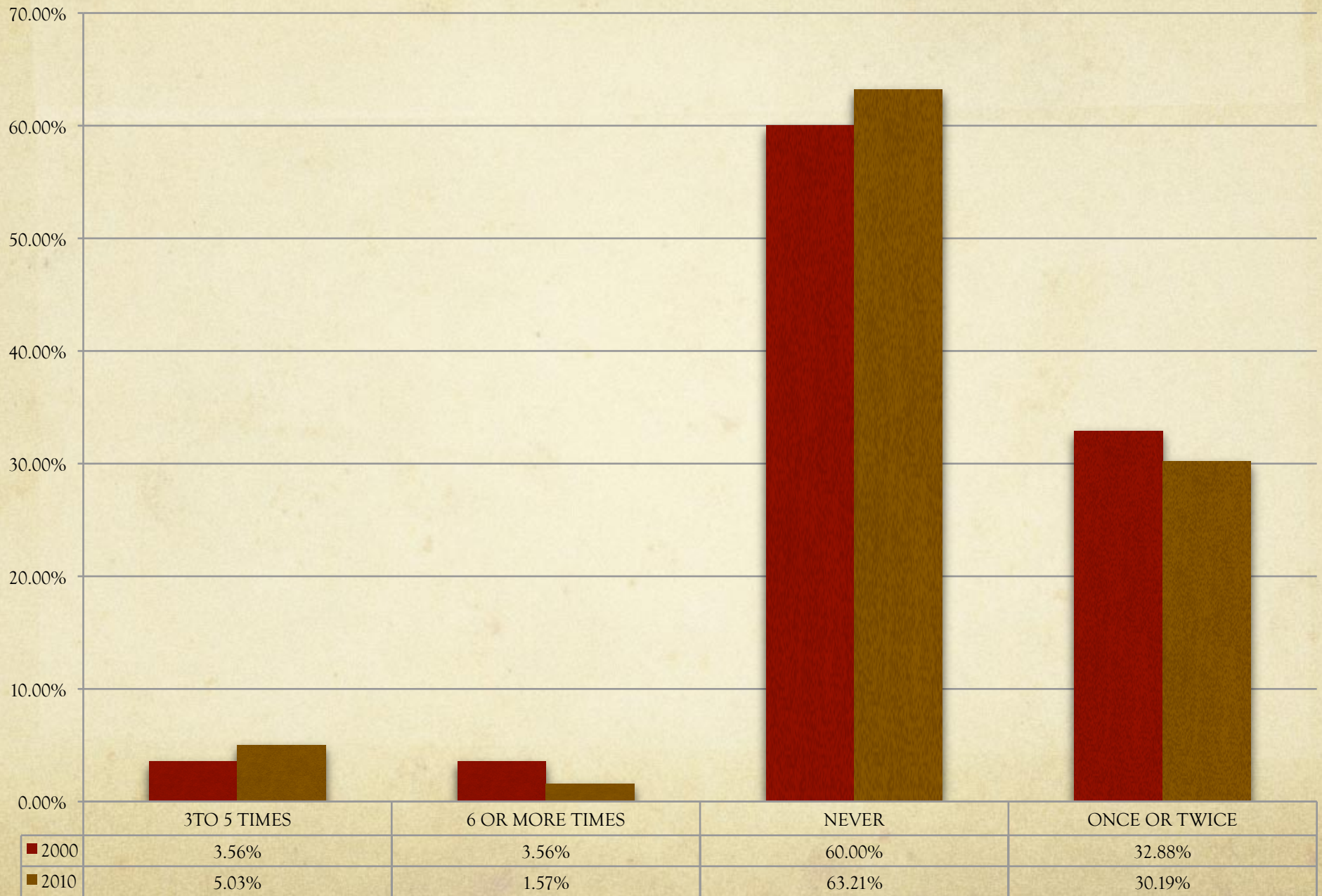
Nearly ALL indicators show a

# 1) How many times have you started a fight or beaten someone up and school?

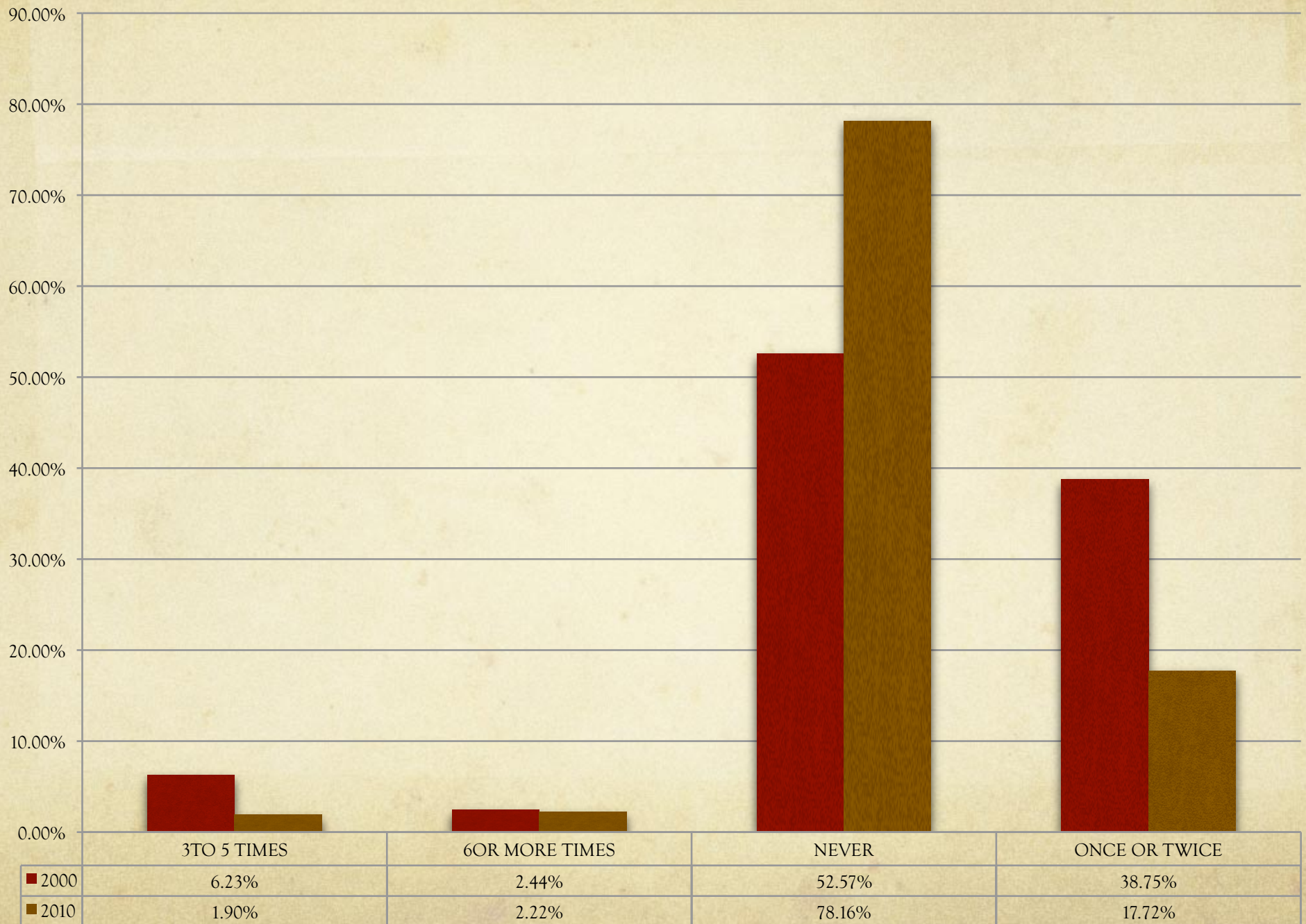




## 2) Have you been in trouble for picking on, bullying, or harassing another student?

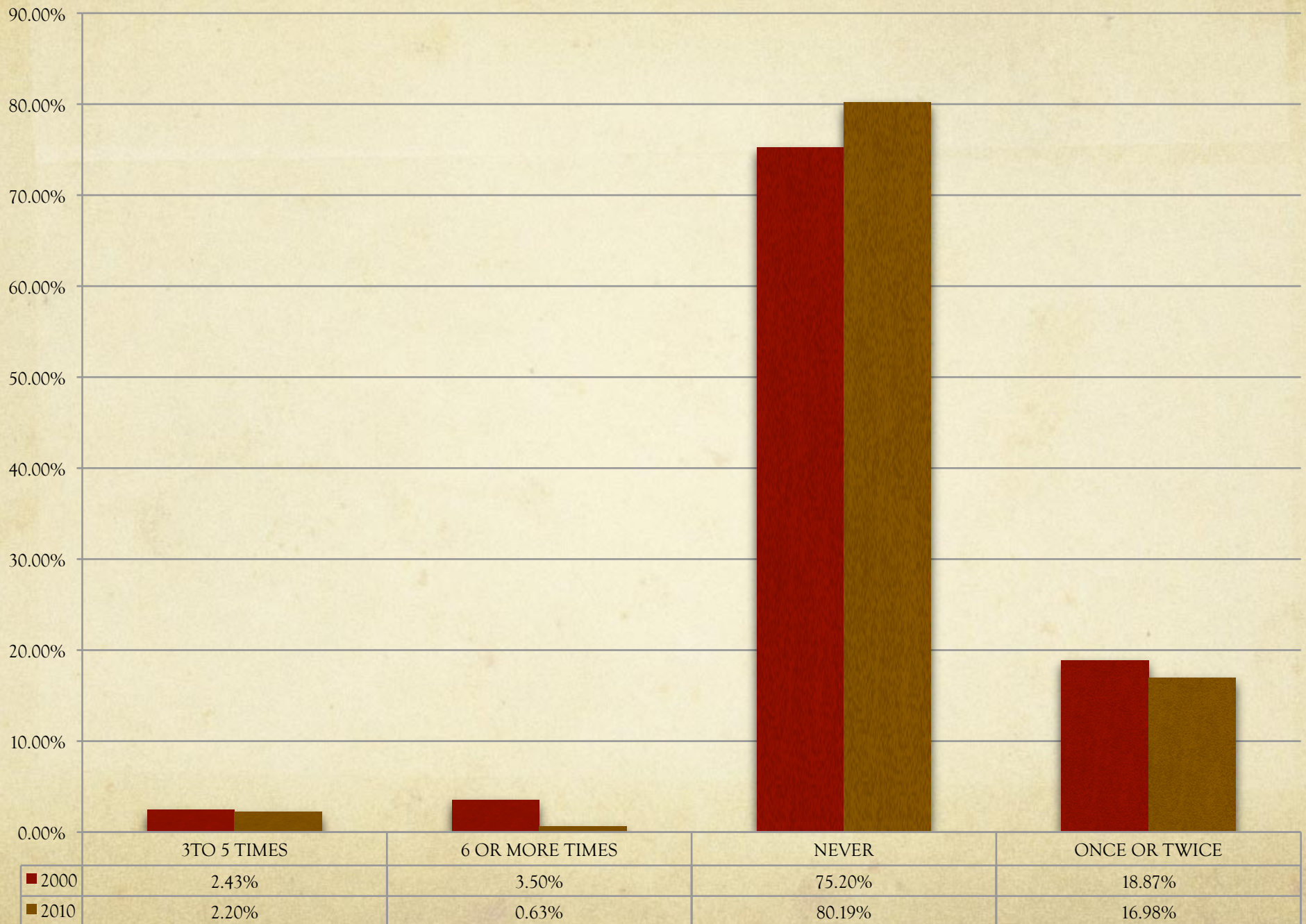


### 3) Have you started rumors or repeated lies about someone at school?

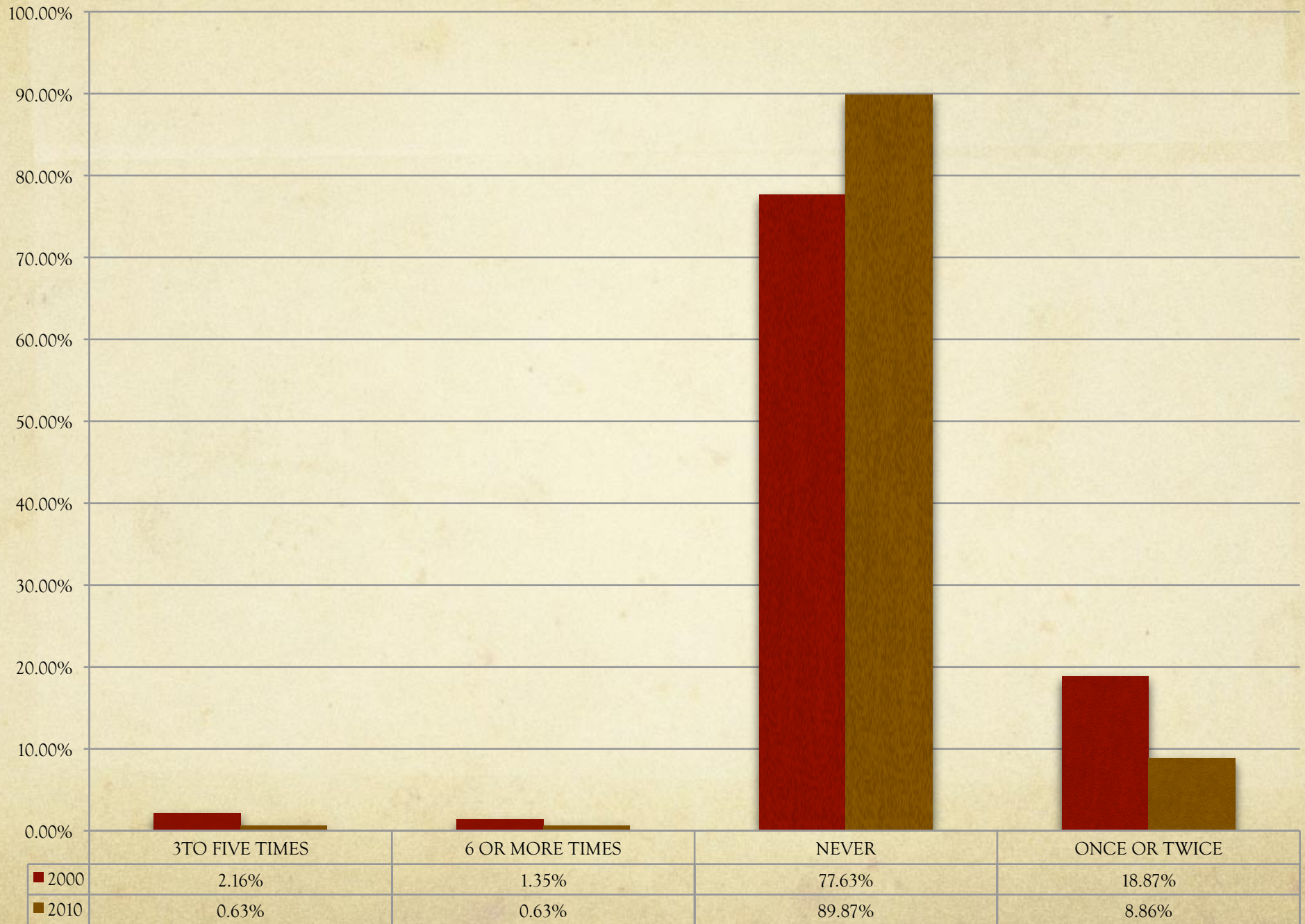




#### 4) Have you been a part of a group who bullied or hurt another student?

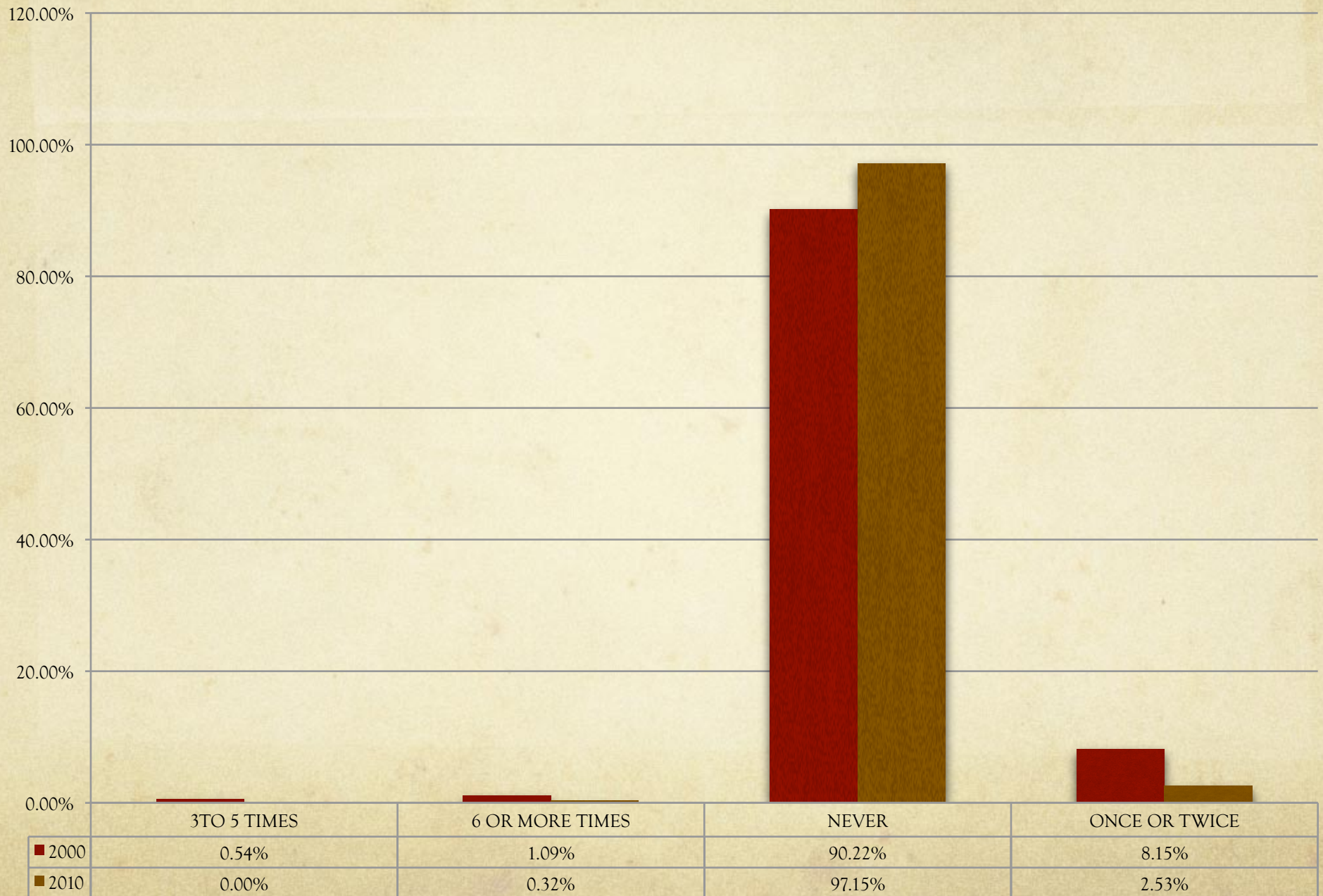


### 5) Have you ever stolen or destroyed another students property?

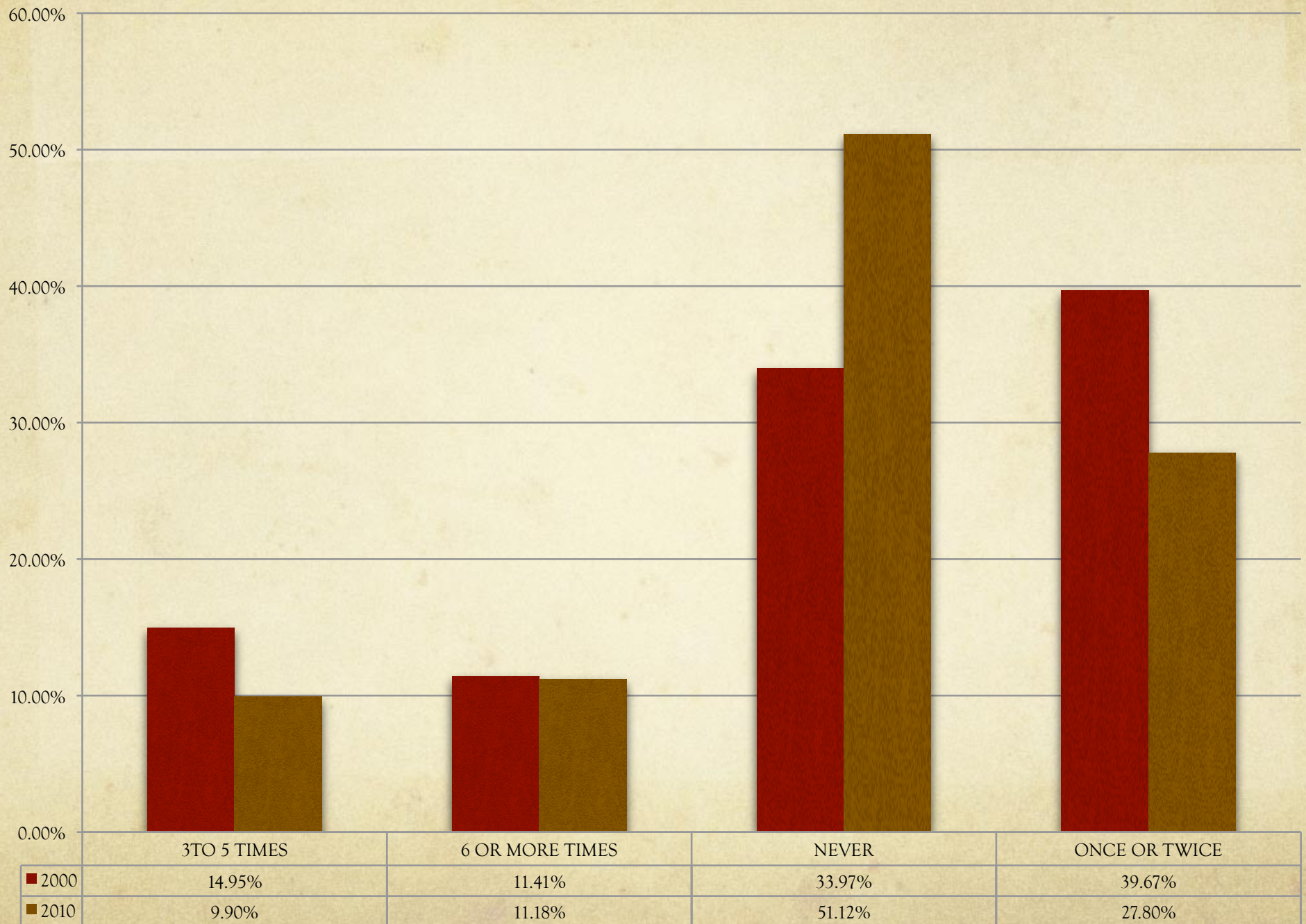




# 6) Have you ever stolen or destroyed property belonging to a staff member or at the school?

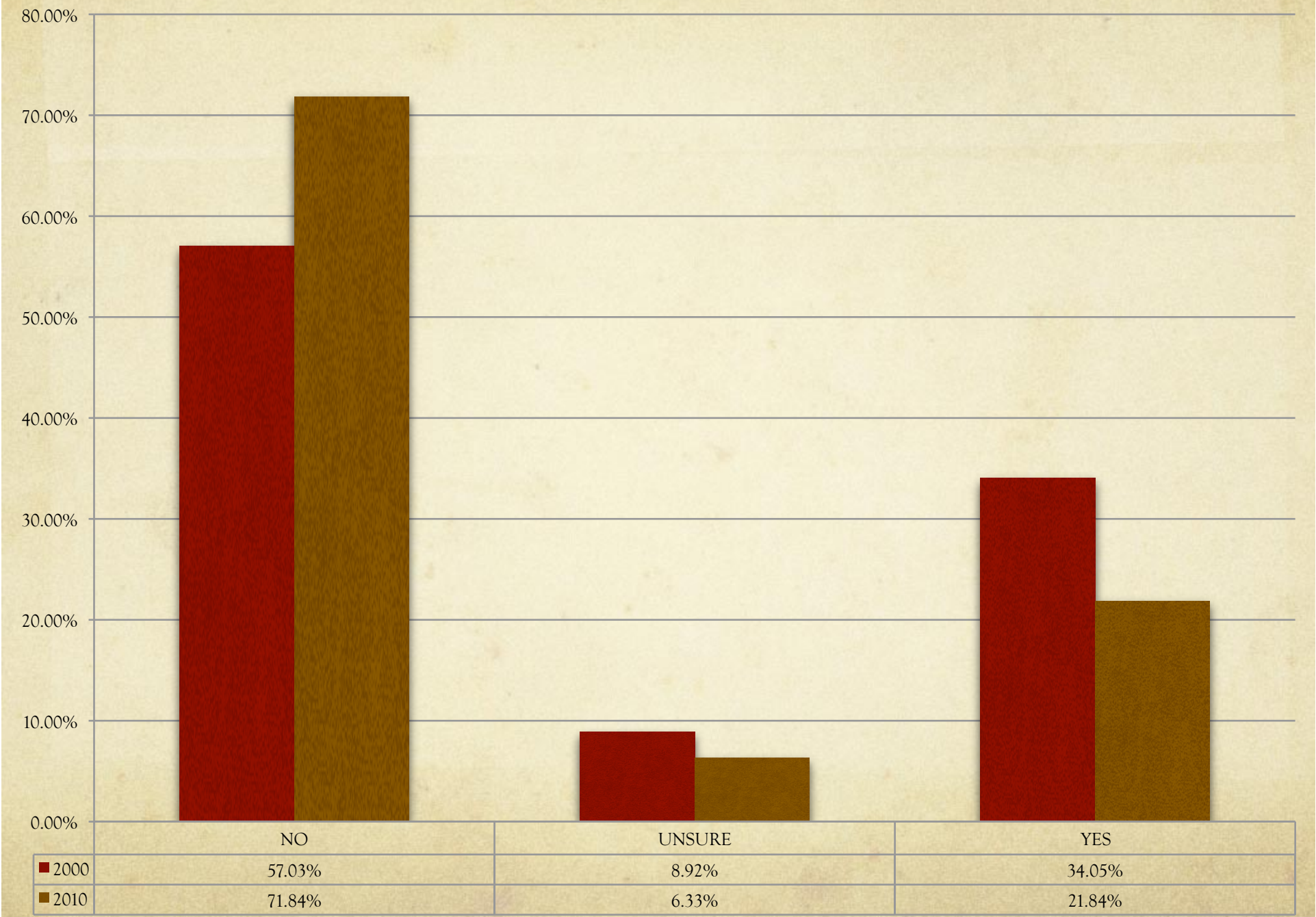


## 7) Have you ever been bullied or harassed by another student at school?

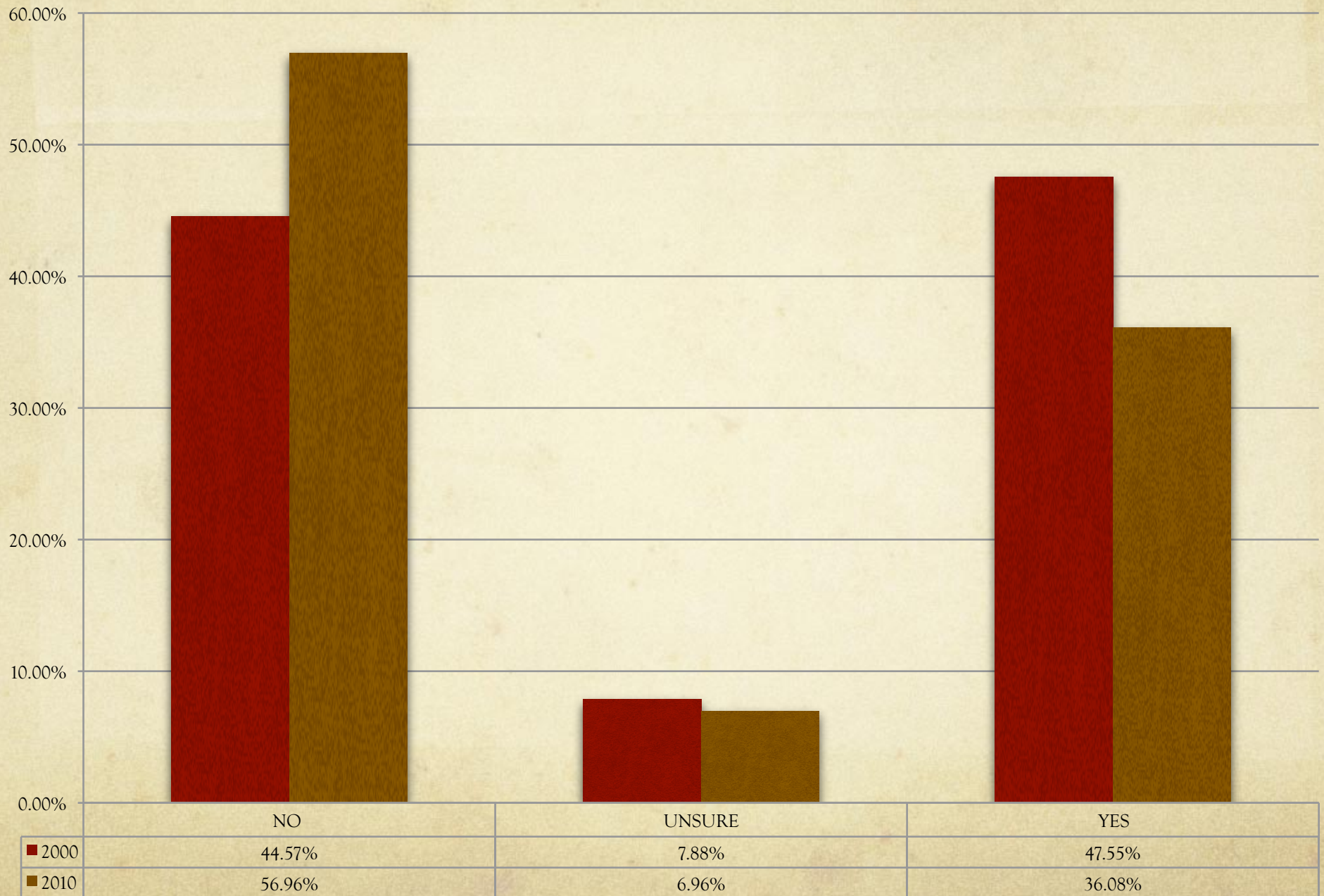




14) Has someone hurt or threatened you in a classroom?

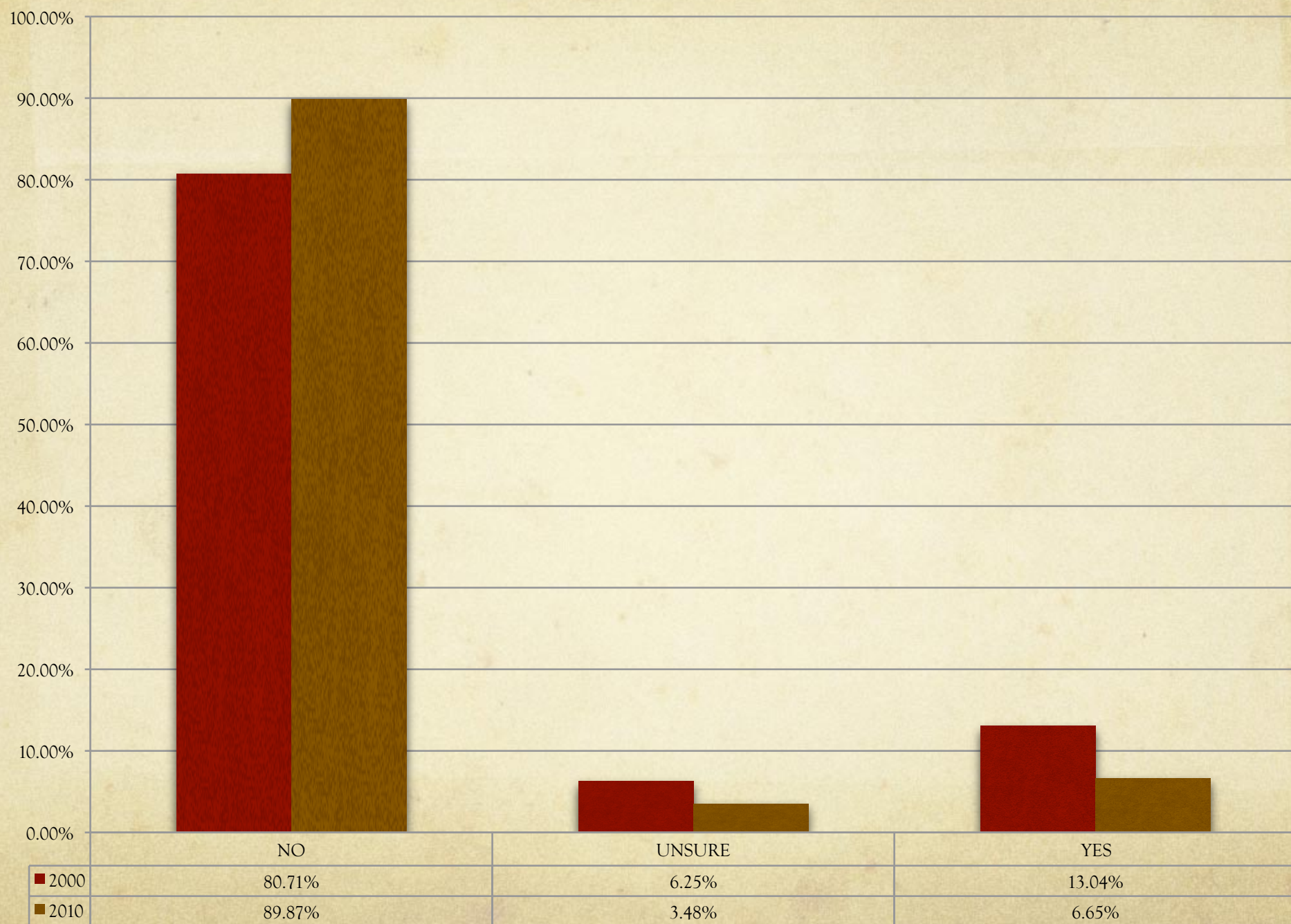


# 15) Has someone hurt or threatened you on the schools ground or playground?

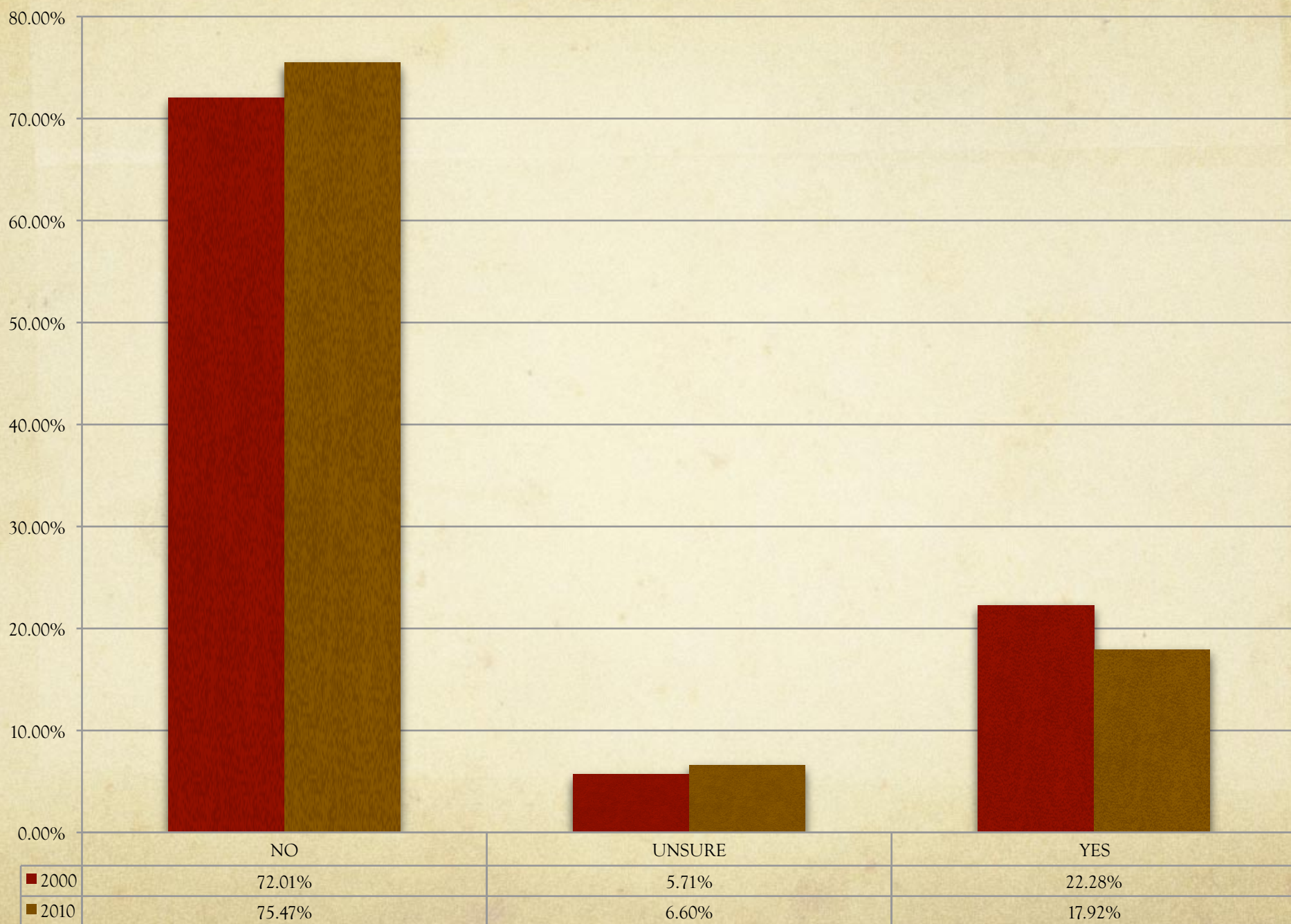




## 16) Has someone hurt or threatened you in the restrooms?

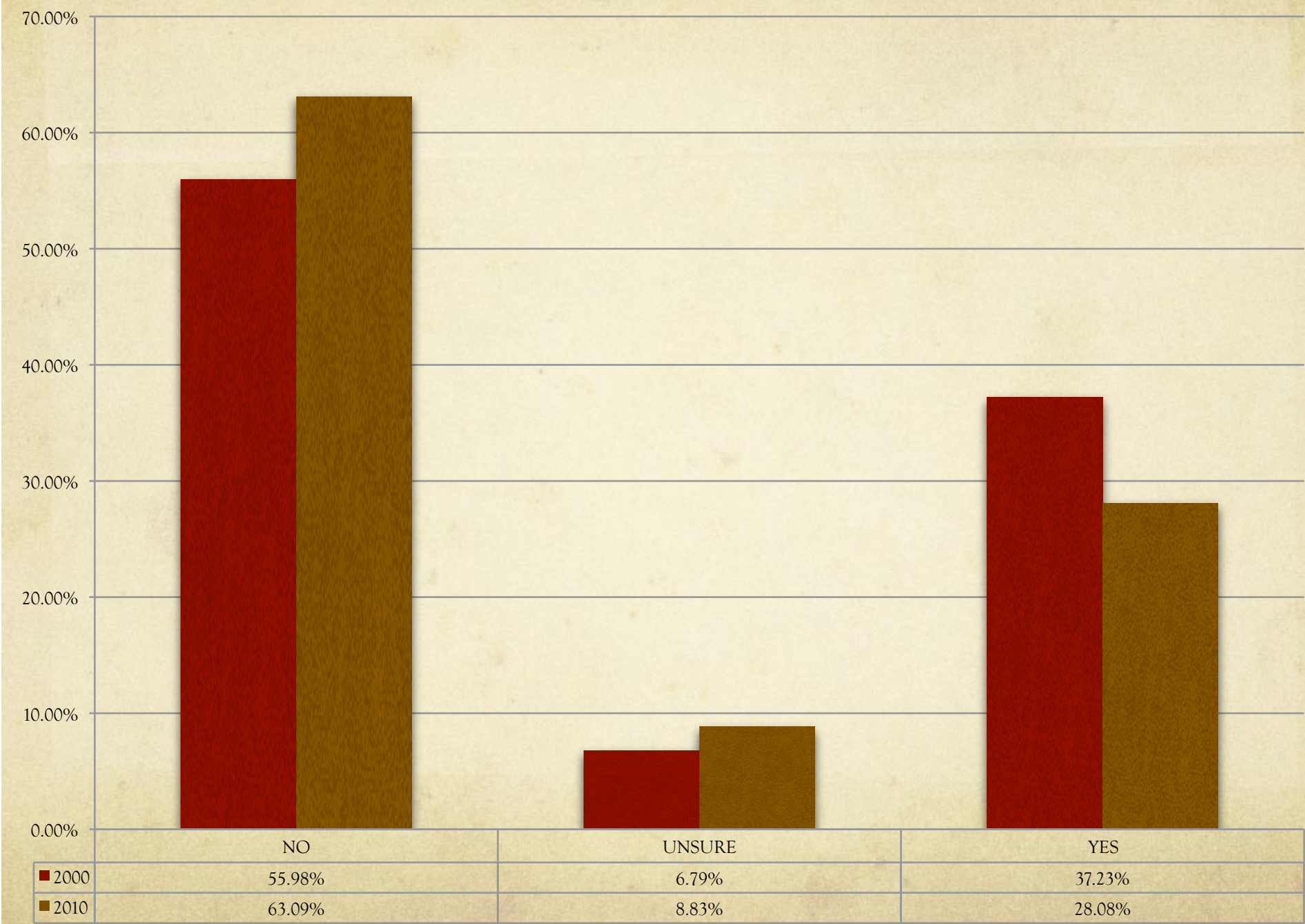


## 17) Has someone hurt or threatened you in the hallways?

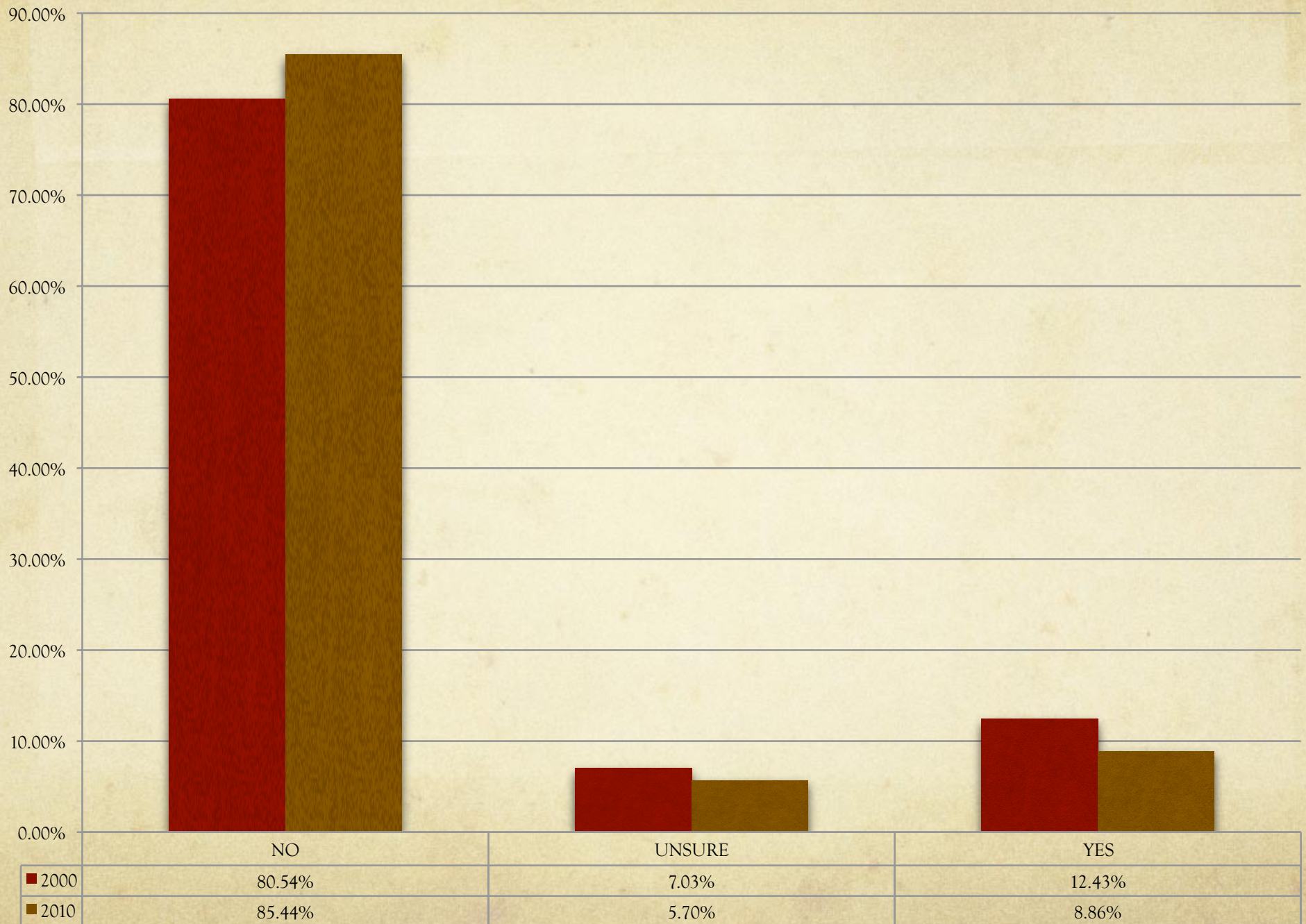




18) Has someone hurt or threatened you on the school bus?

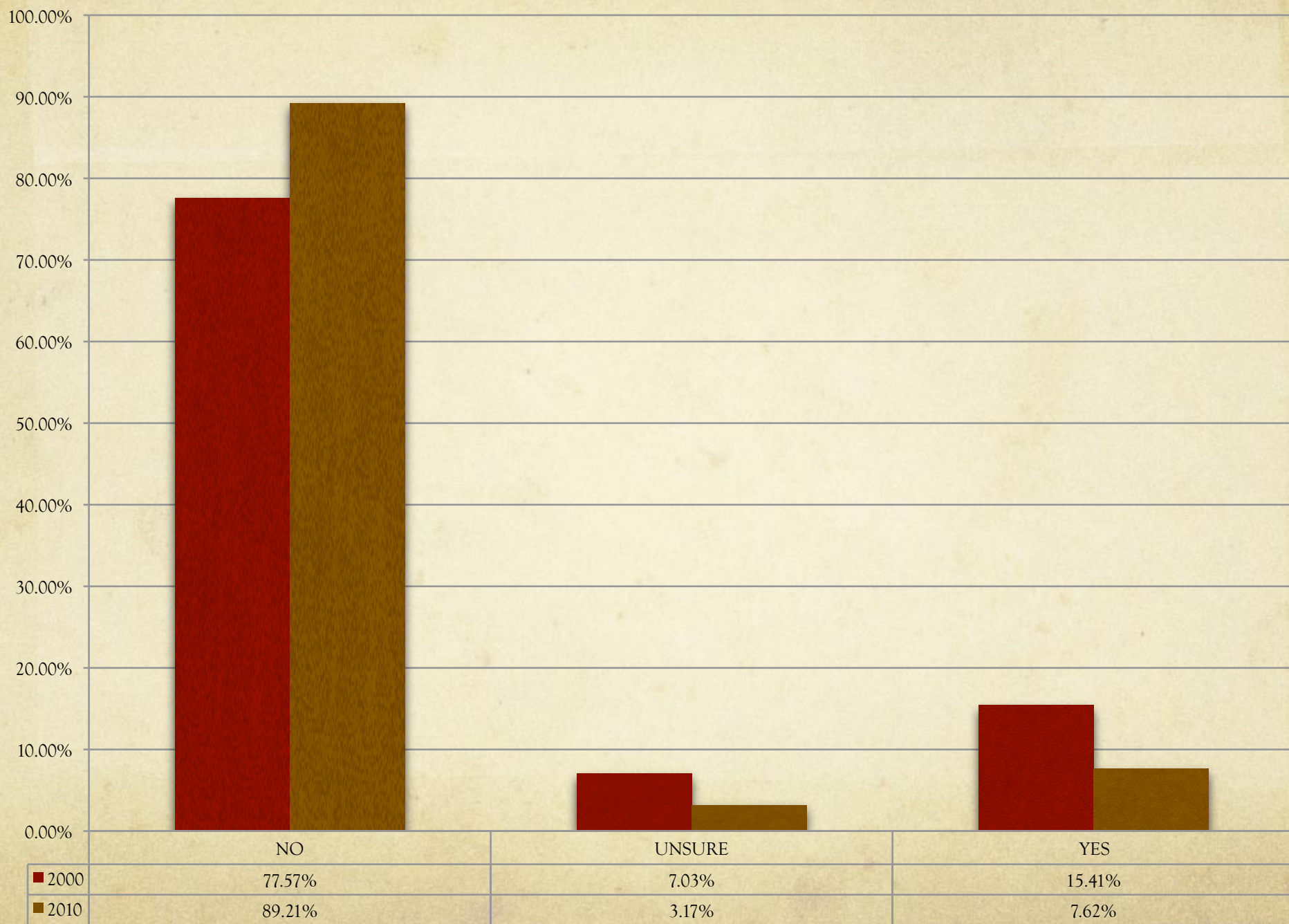


## 19) Has someone hurt or threatened you in the school entrances or exits?

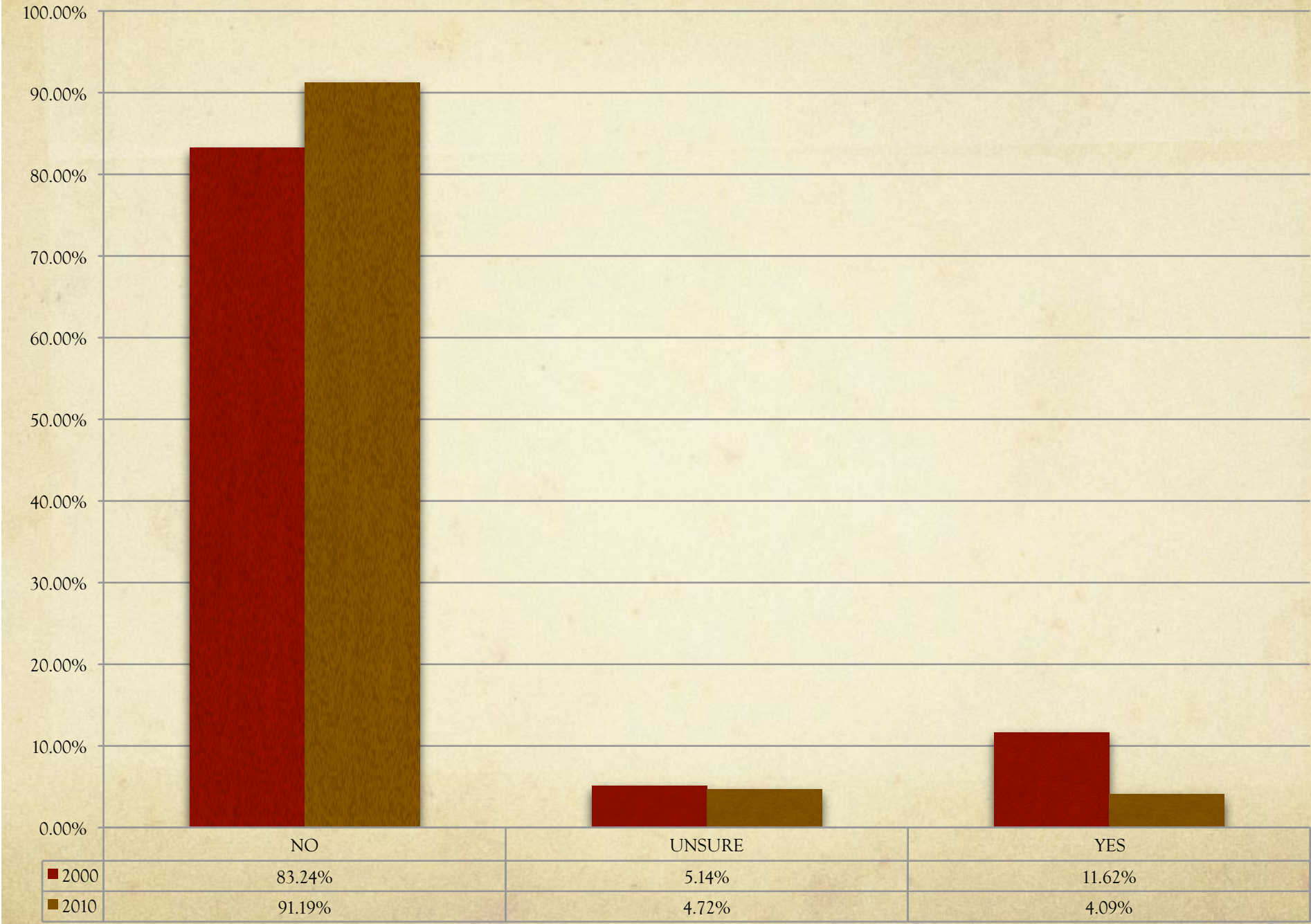

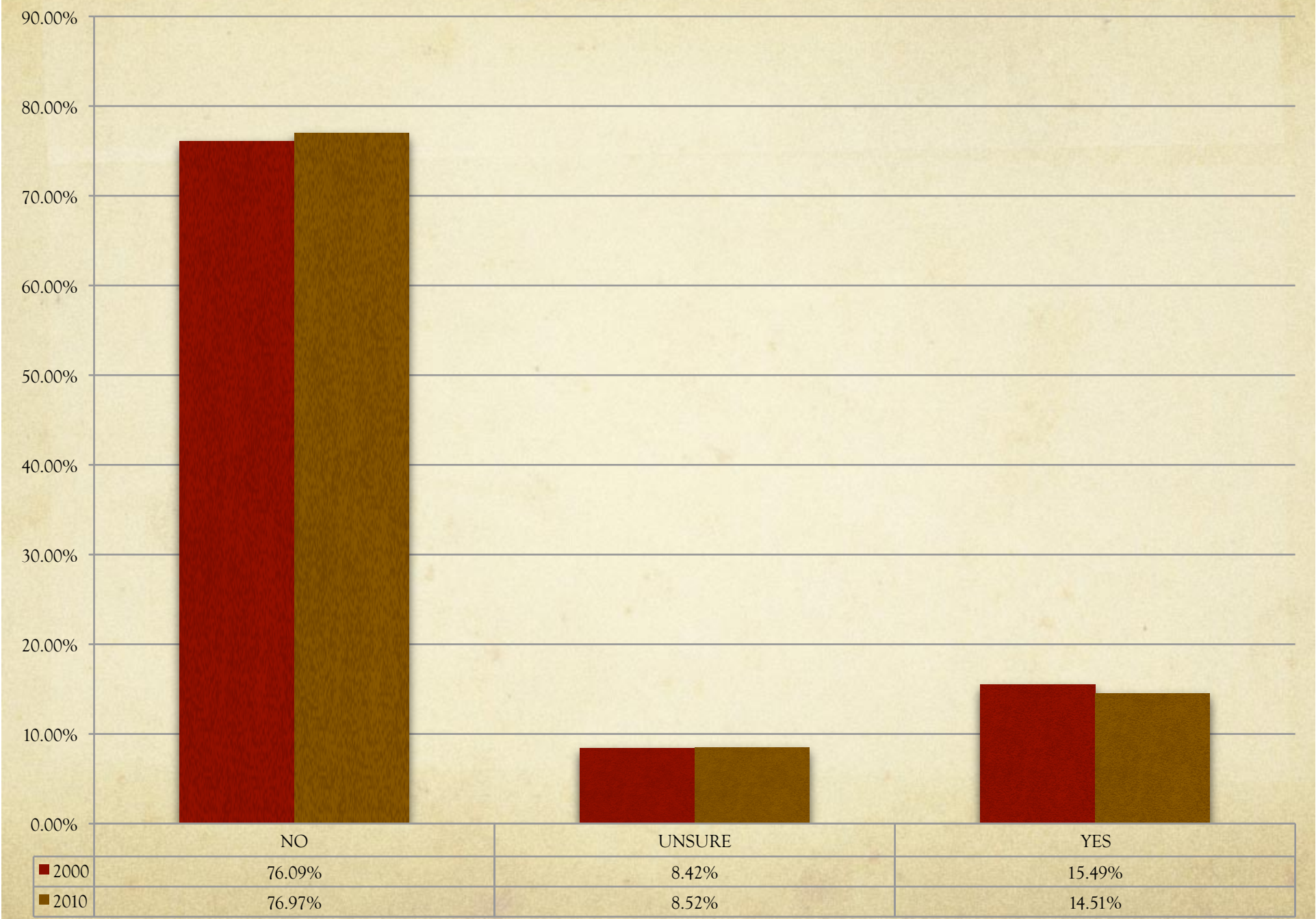

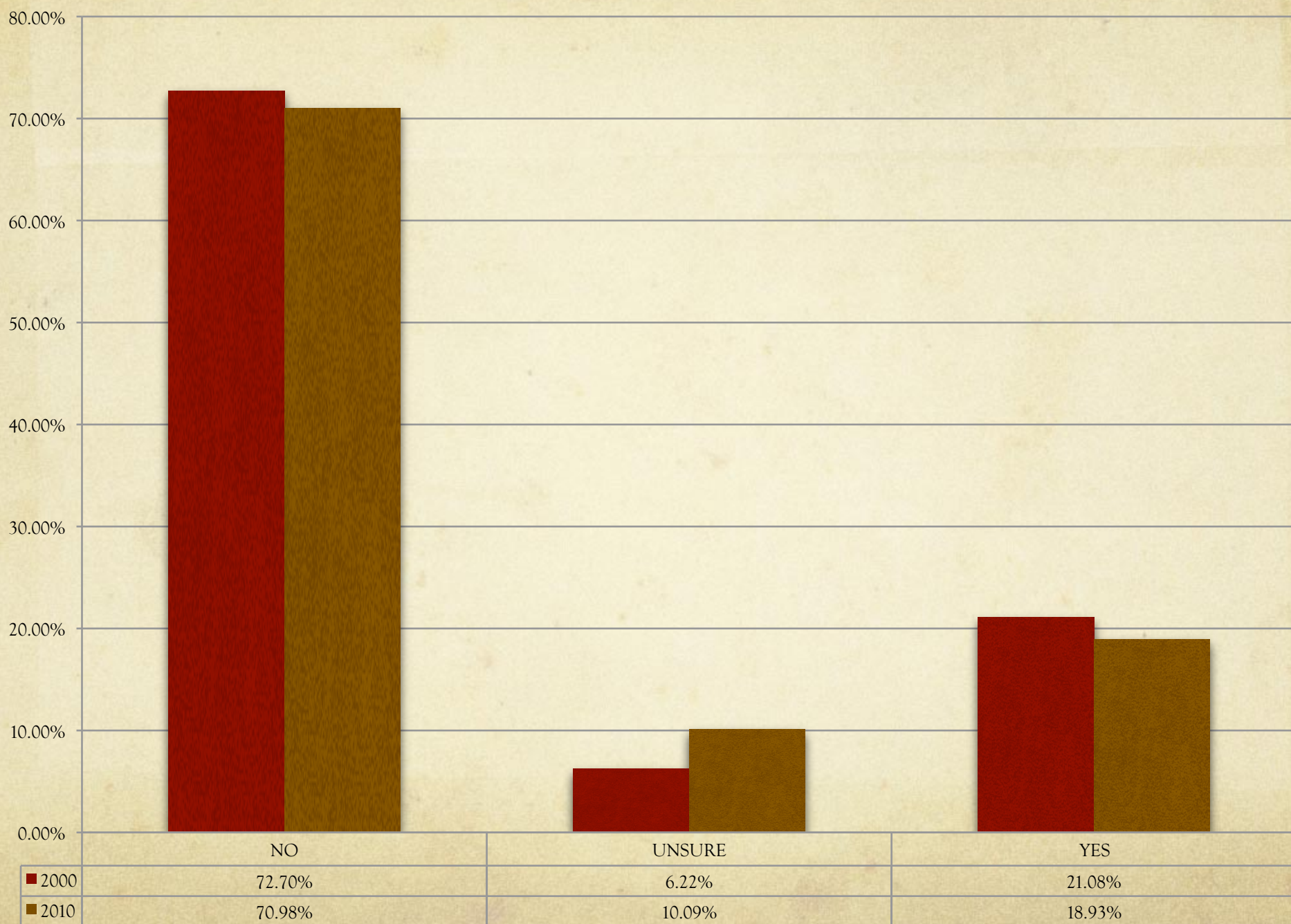

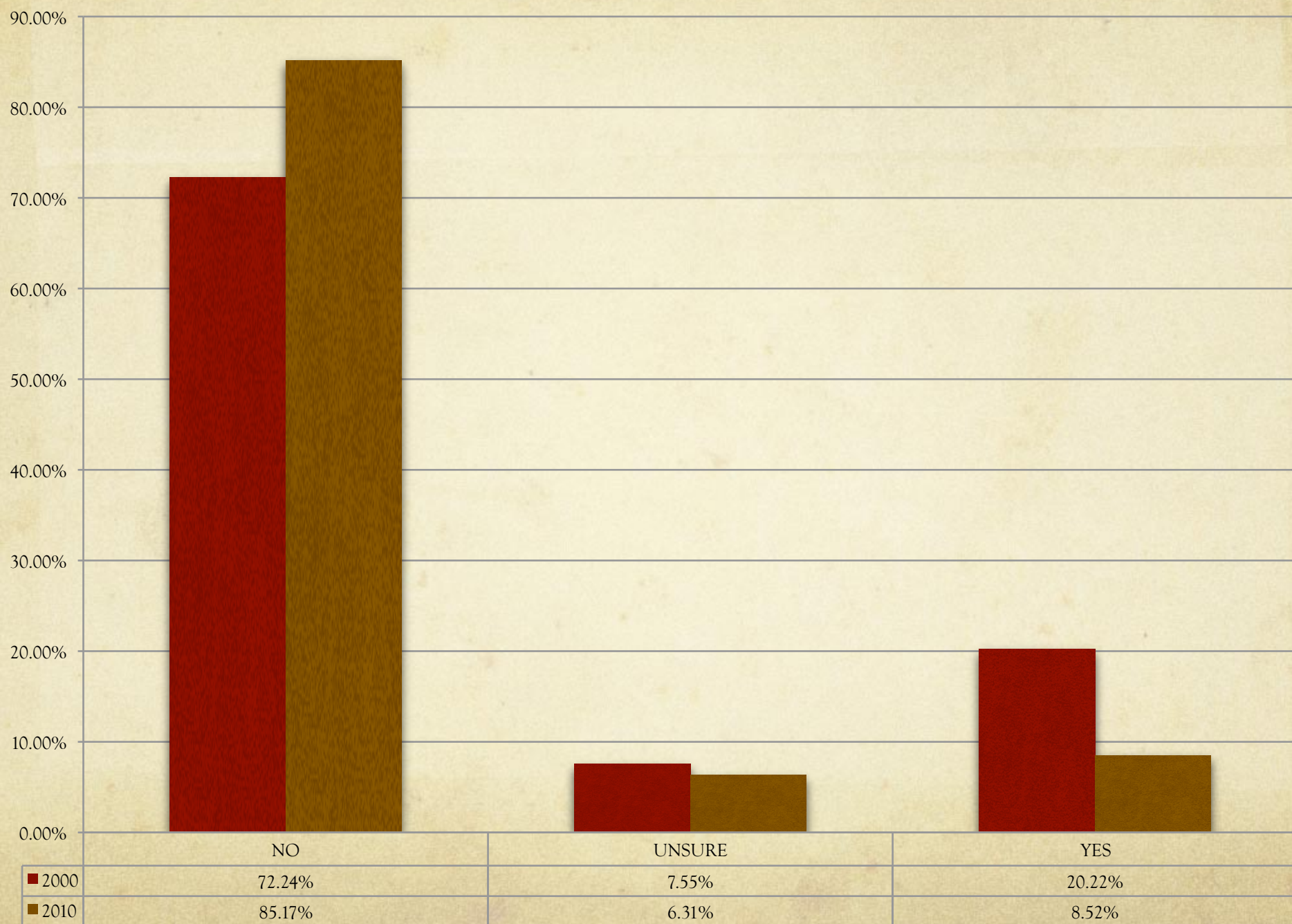


## 23) Has someone hurt or threatened you at after school activities?

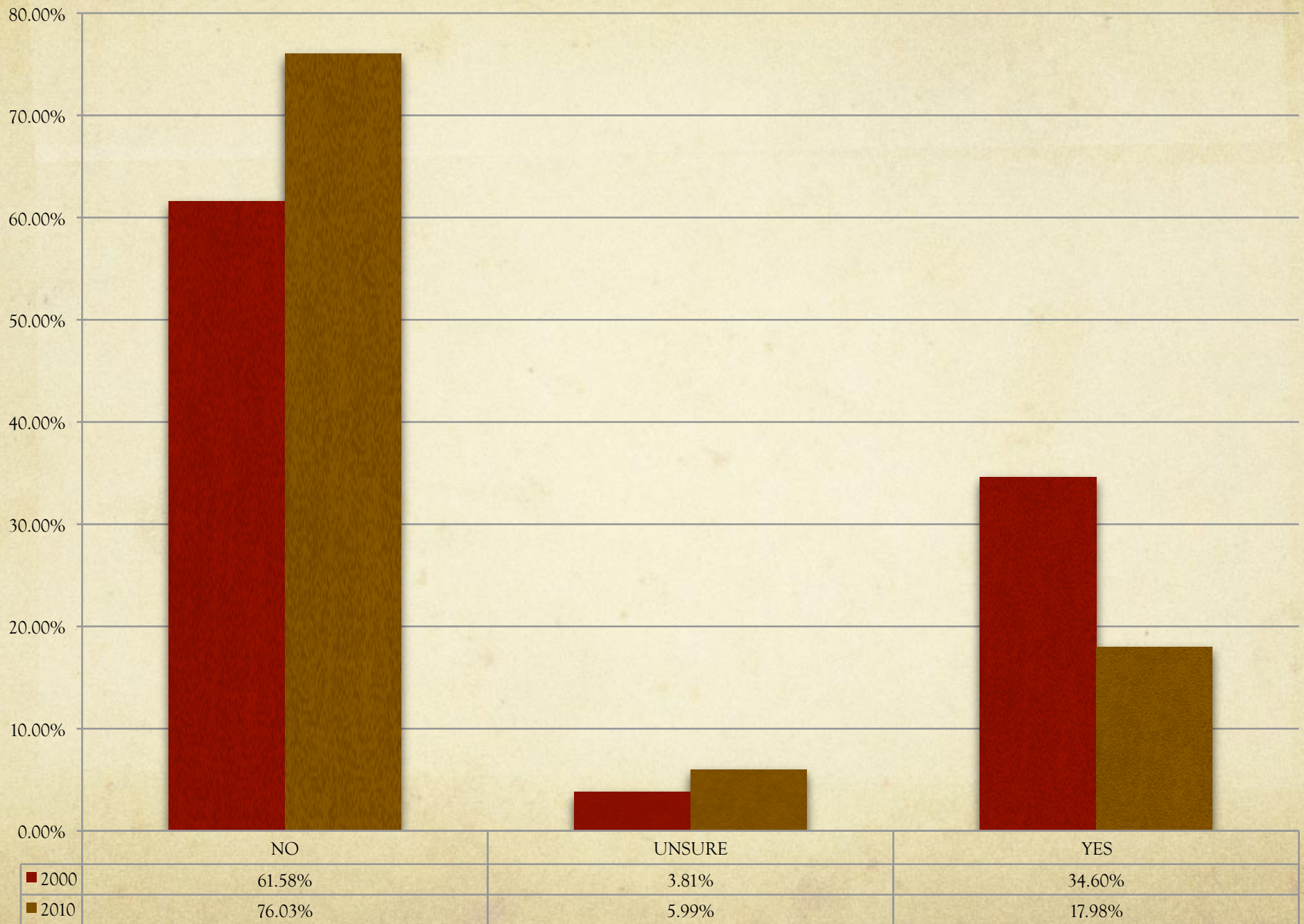

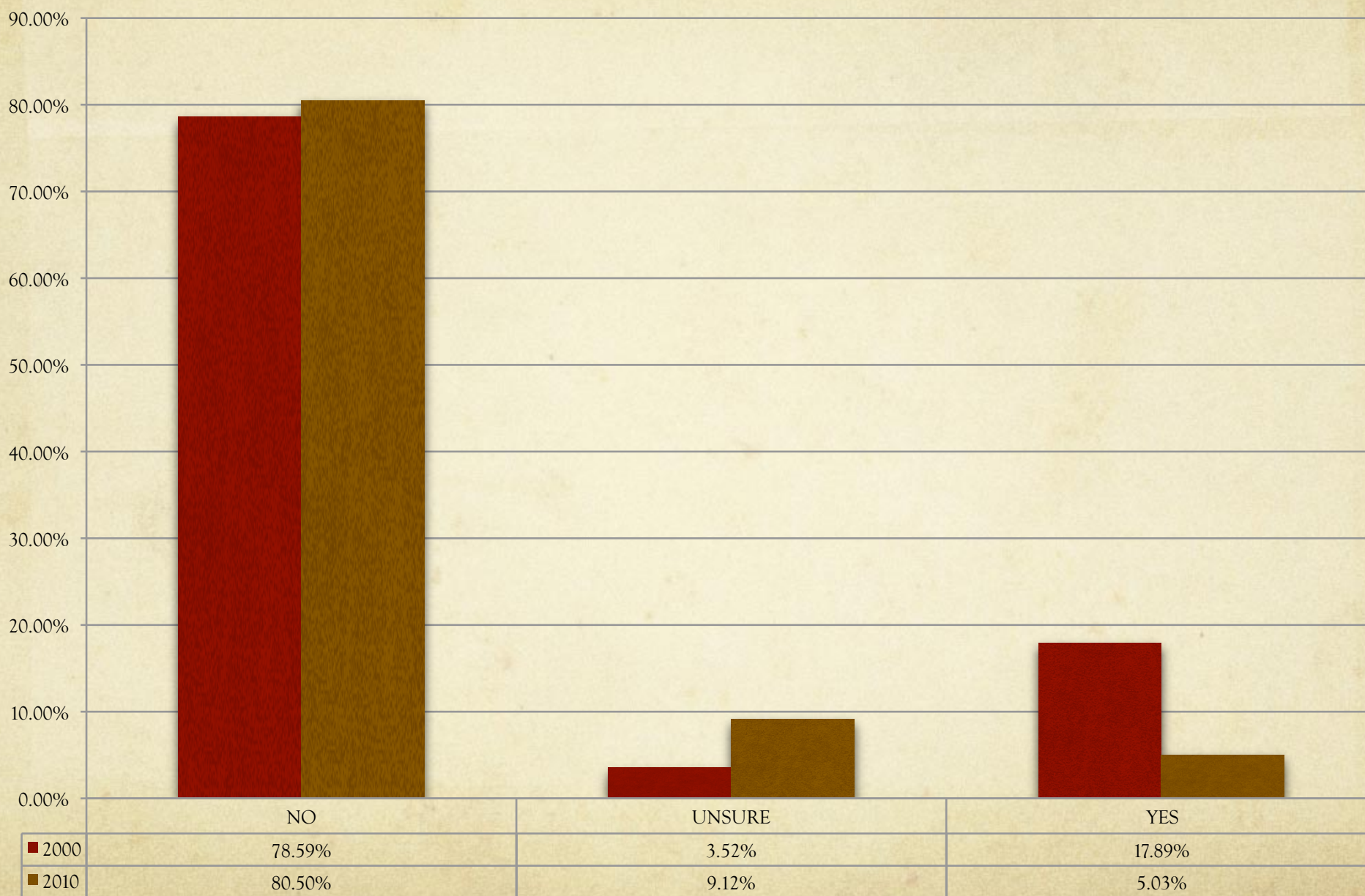

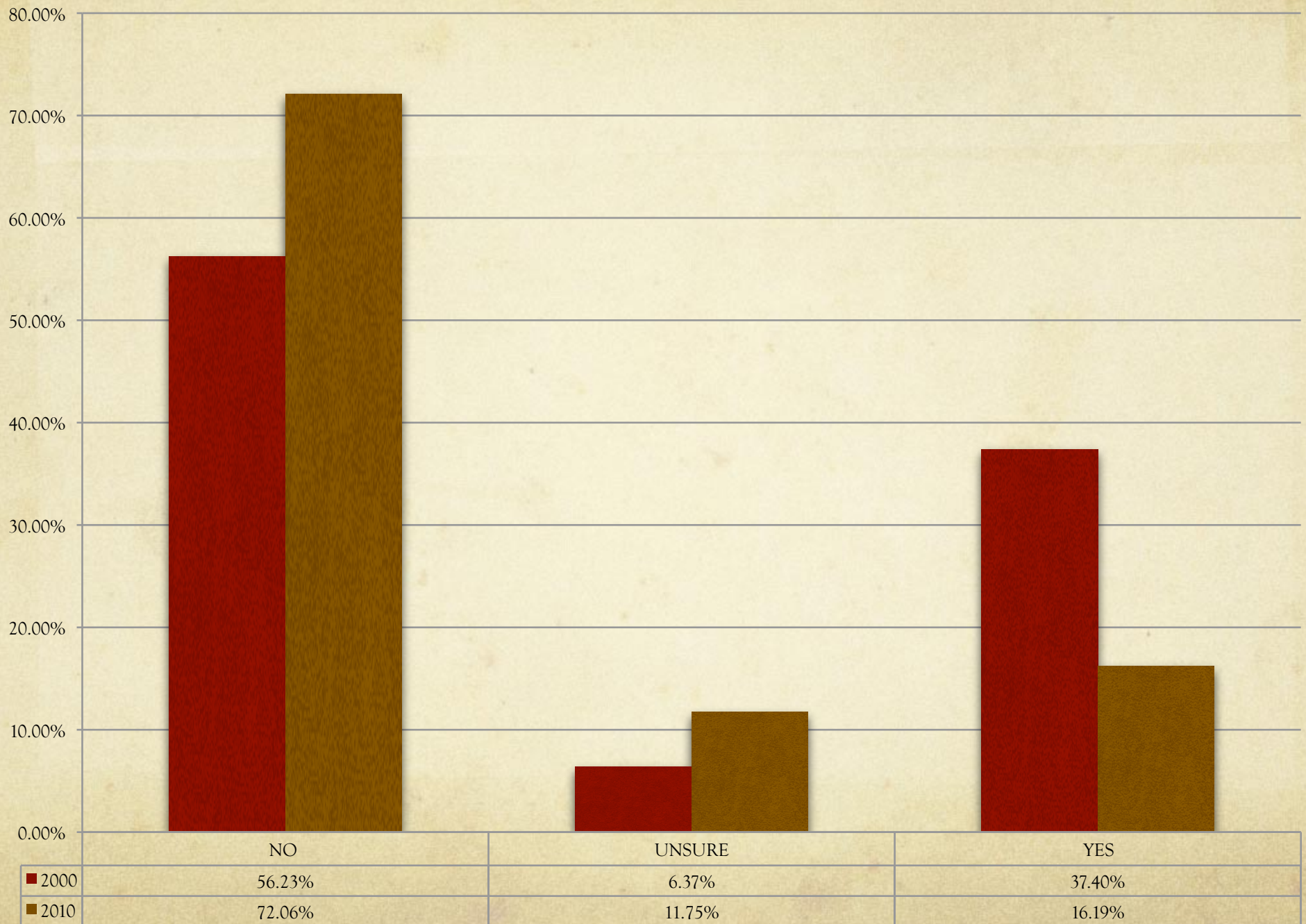

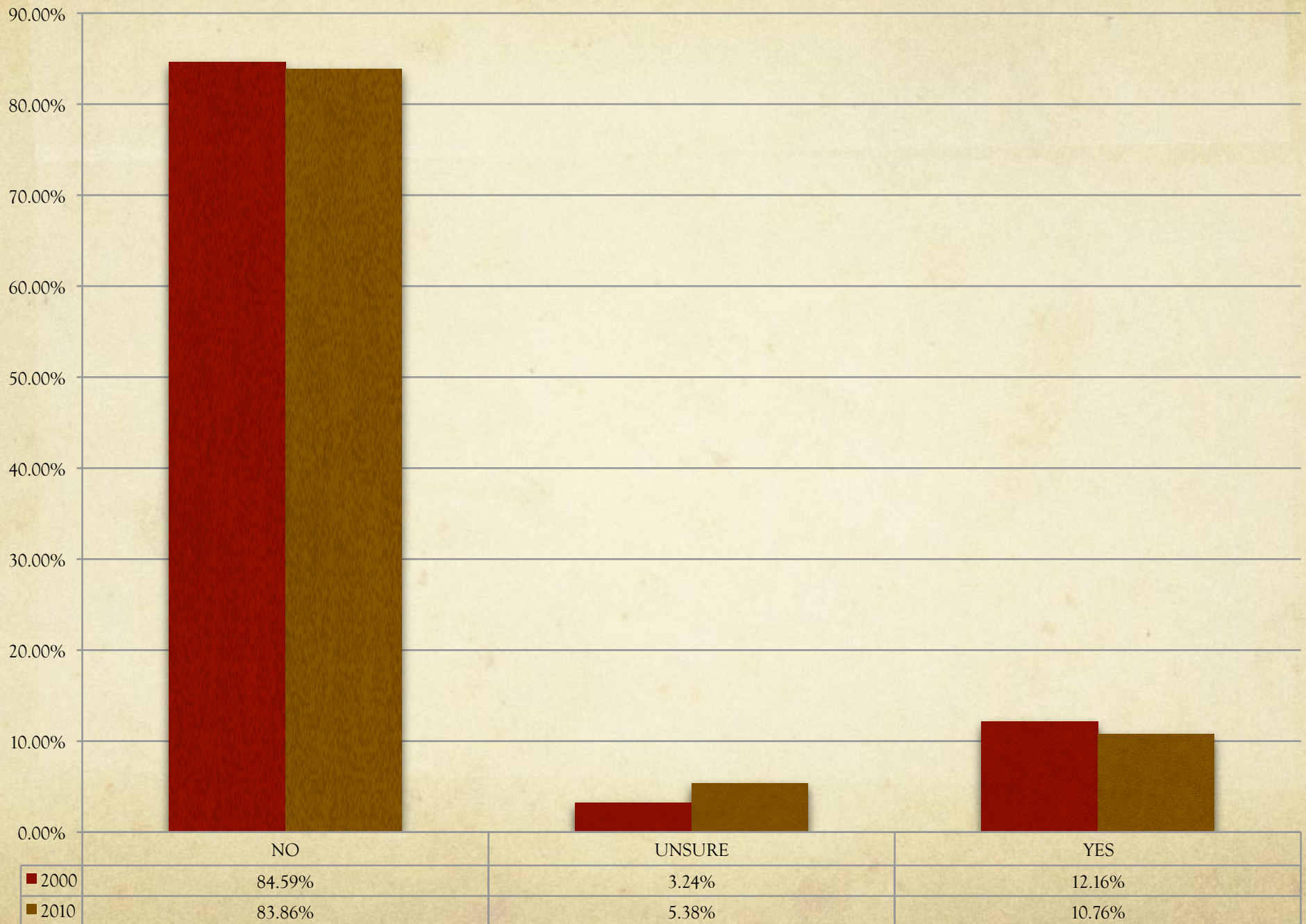

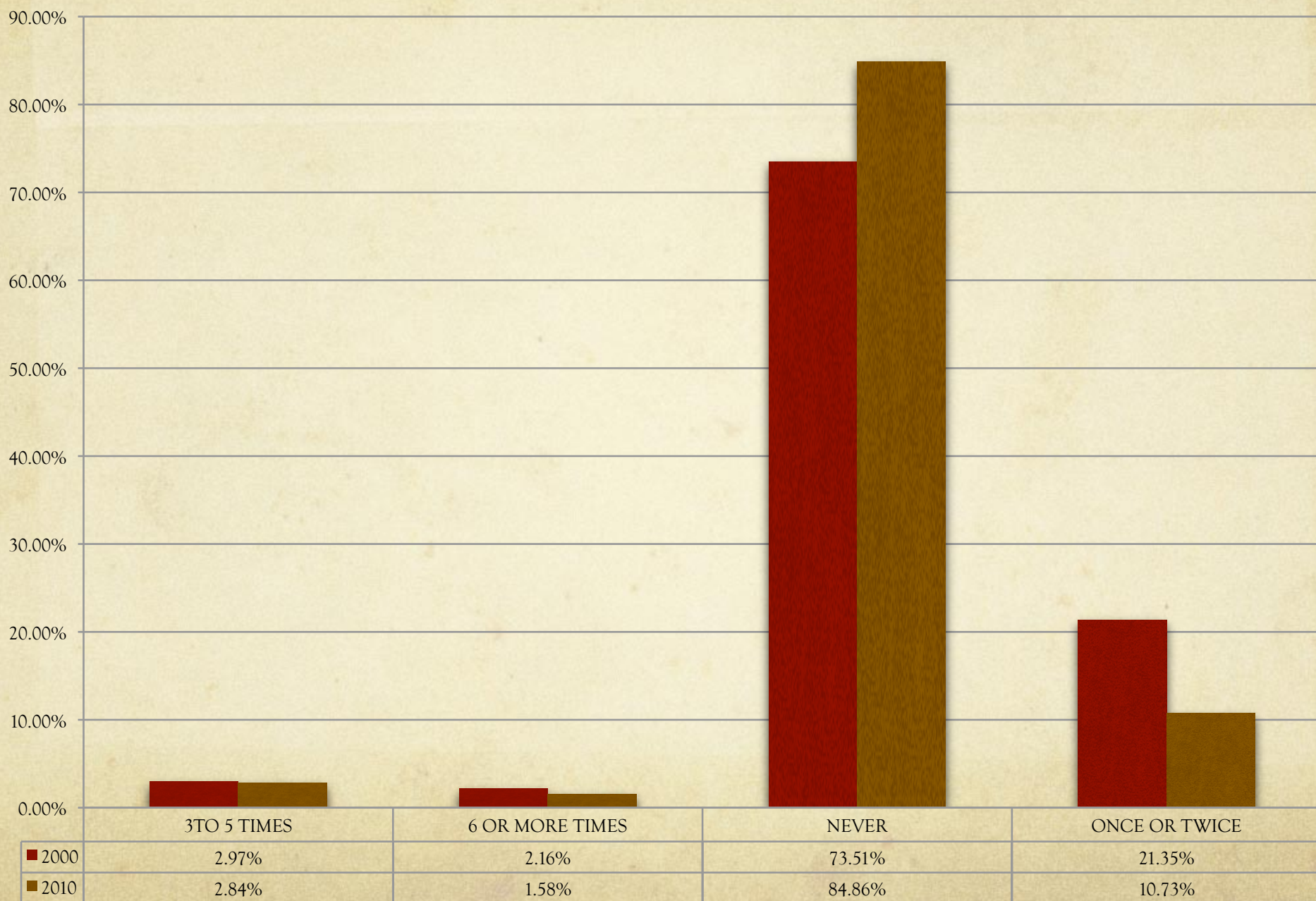

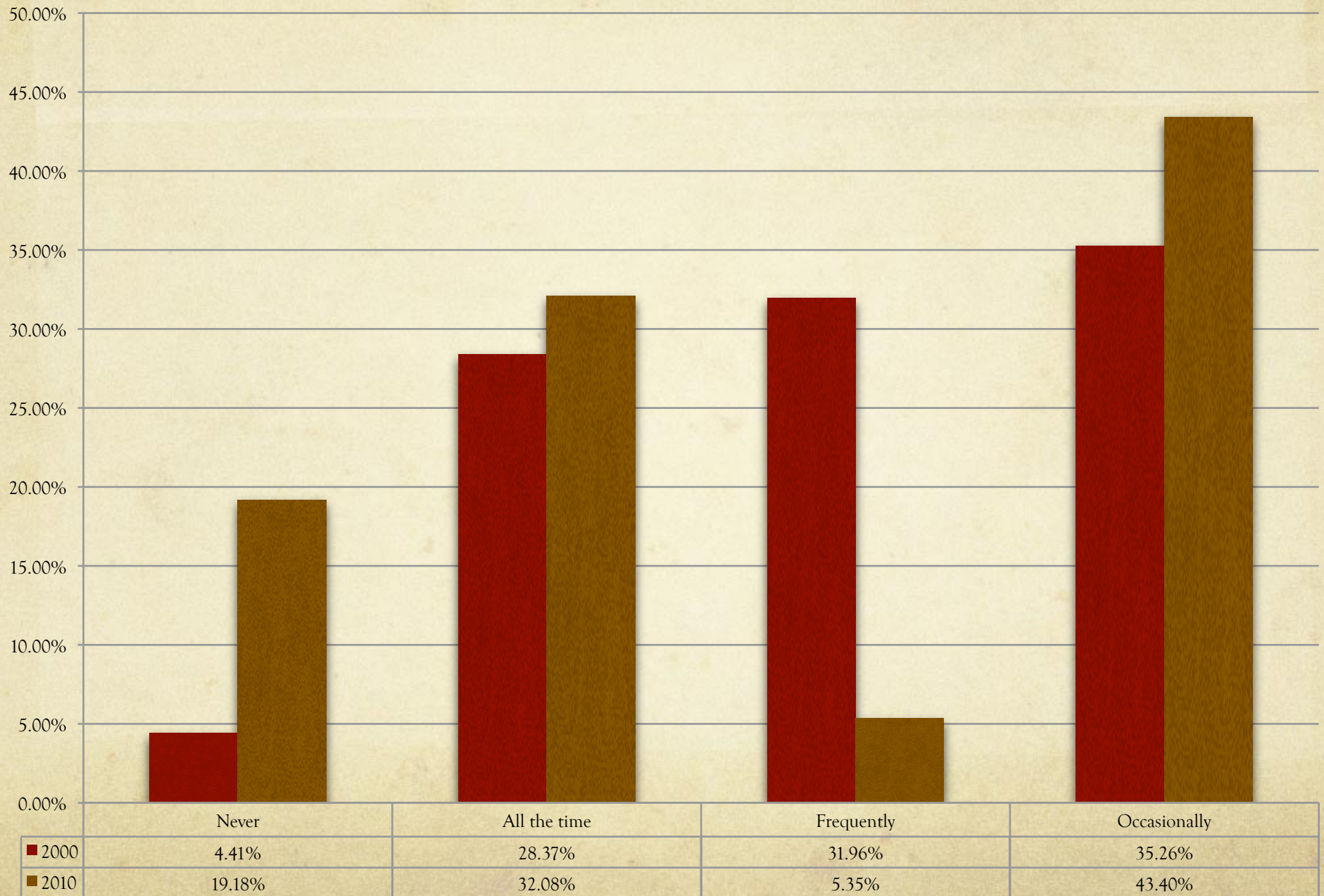

## 8) How many times have you missed school because of fears of being bullied by another student?

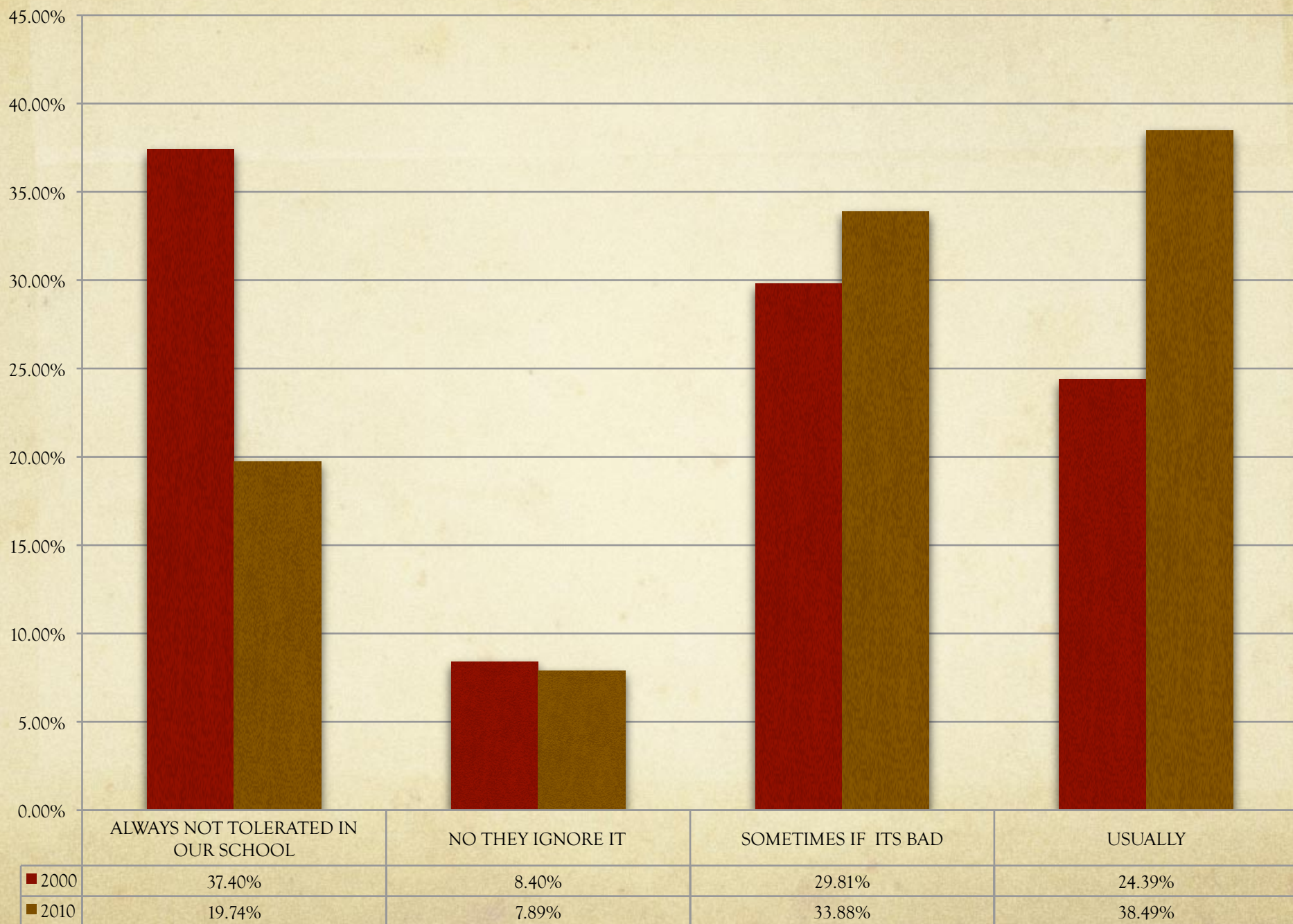


## 9) How often do you think students bully or harass other students in our school?

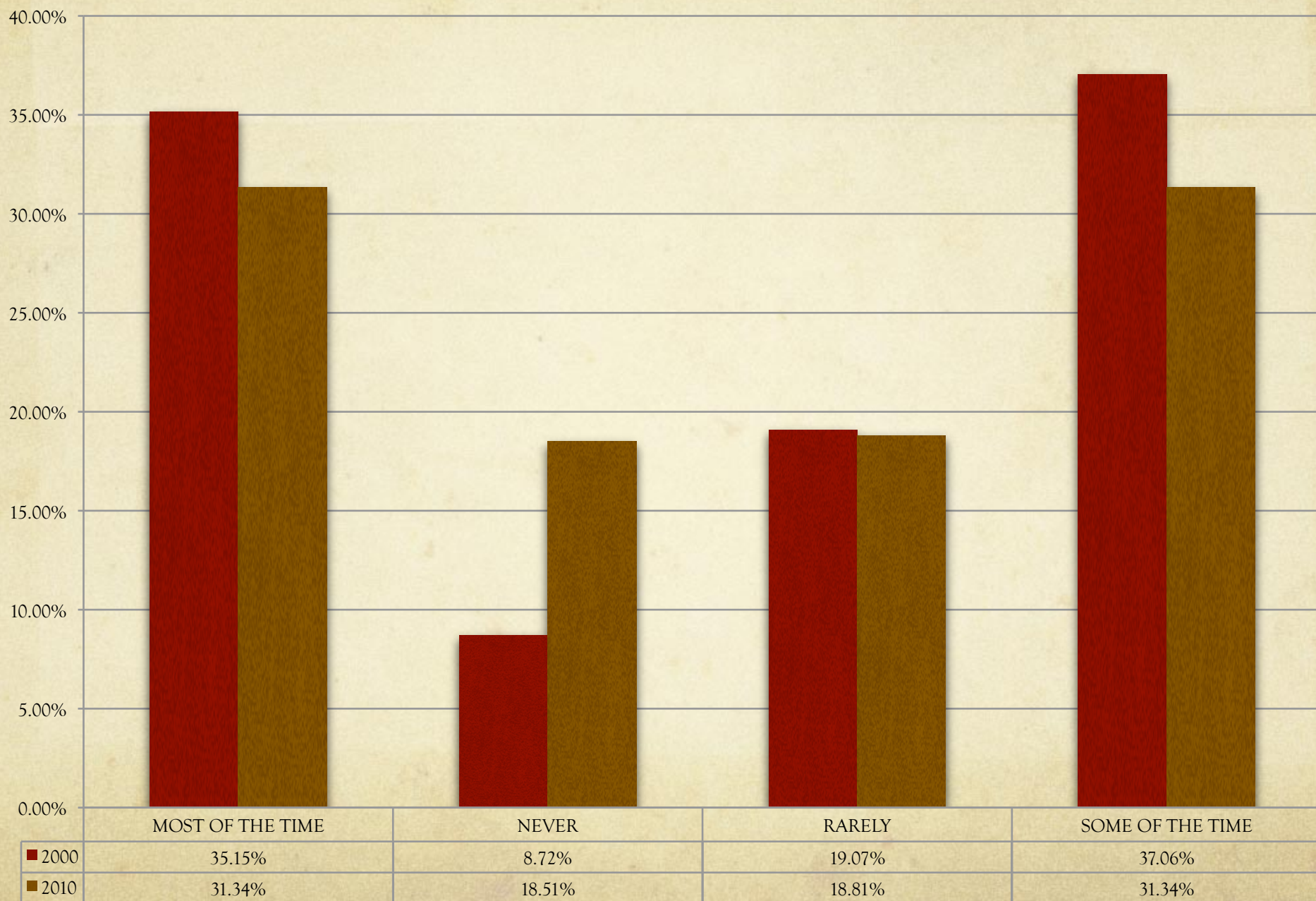




## 10) Do staff members try to protect students from bullying/ harassment



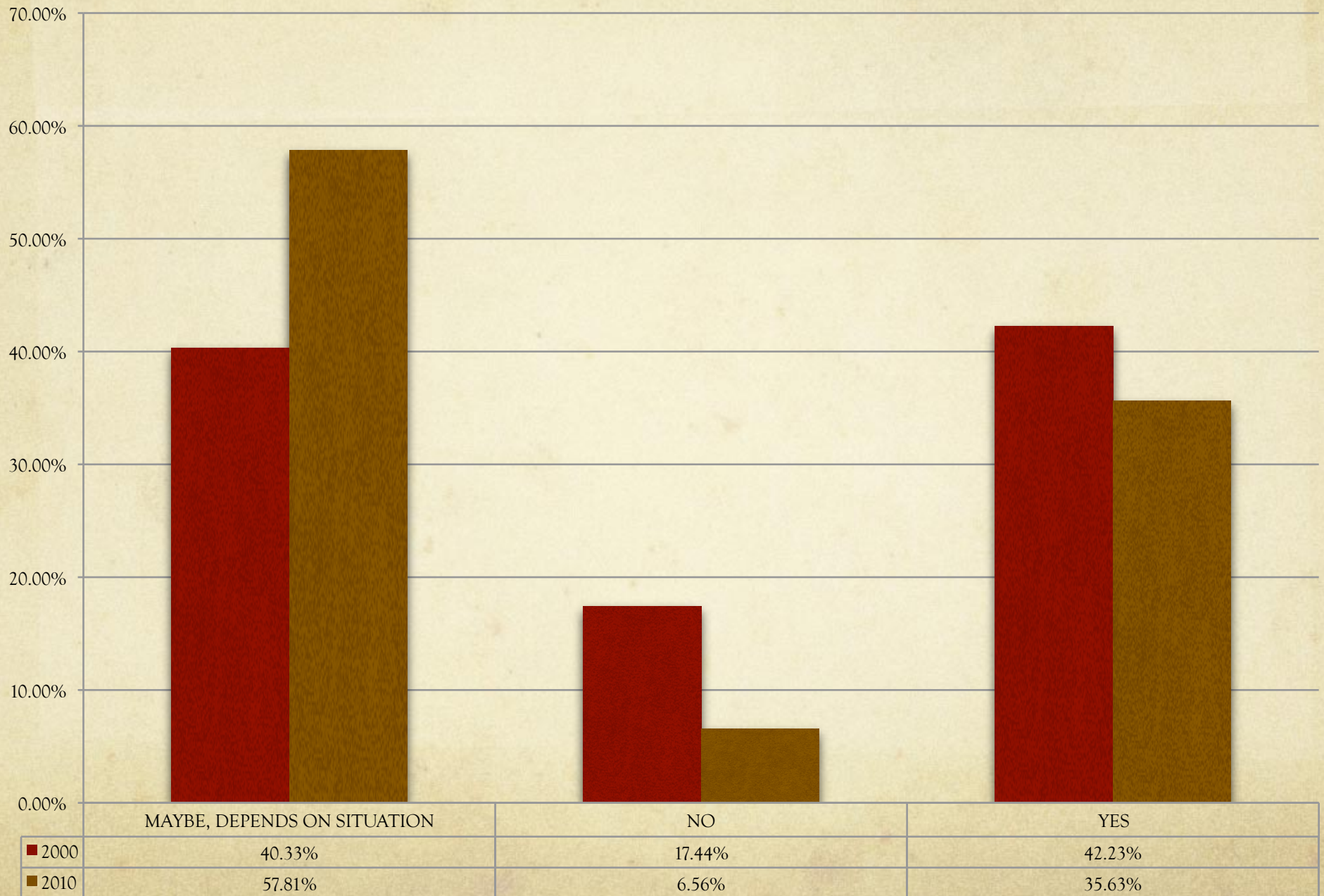
# 11) Do you think staff (teachers, coaches, aides, etc.) are effective at stopping bullying/harassment in school?

## 29) Can you count on adults in your school to protect you from being hurt by others?

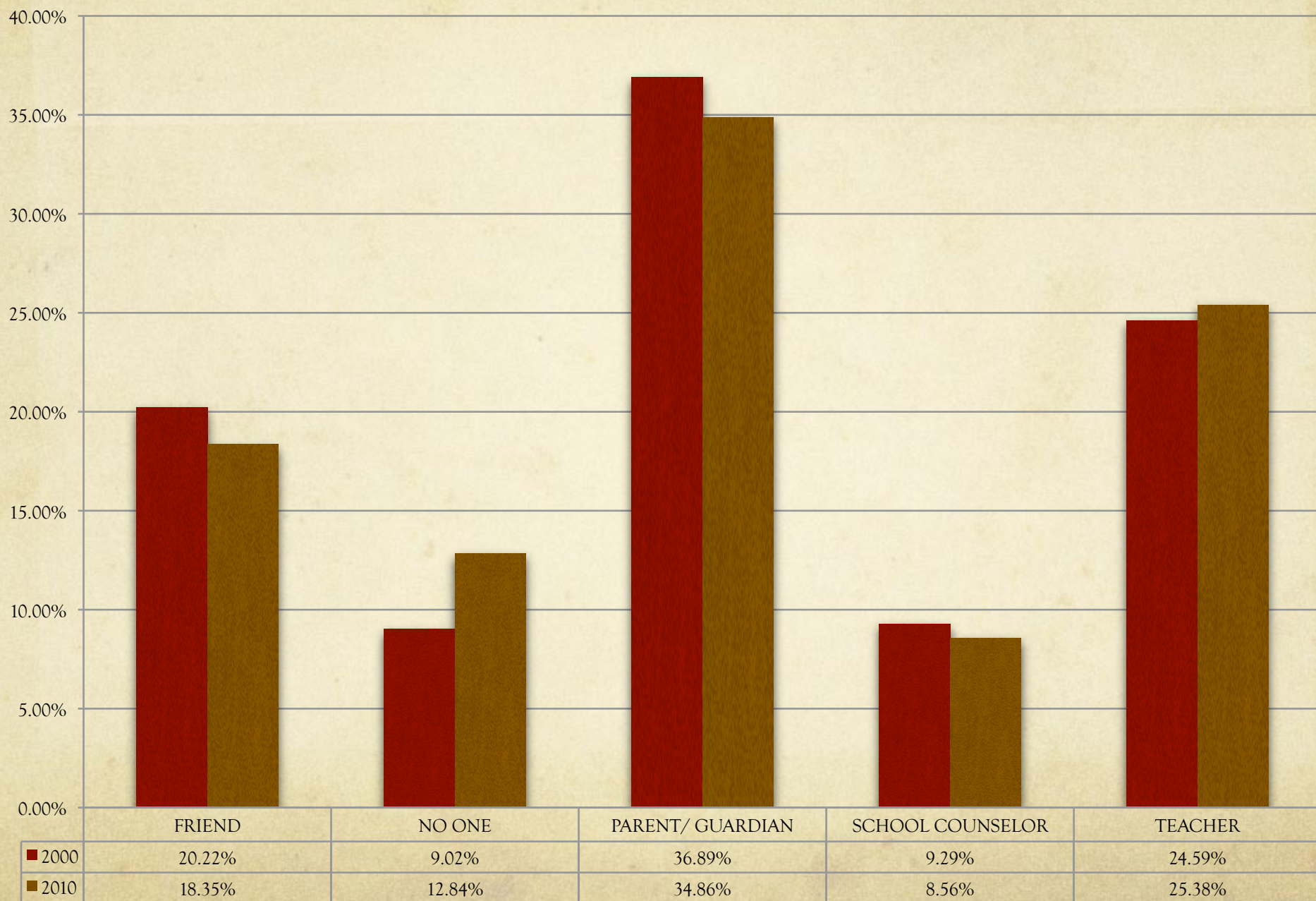




One Indicator shows that students are more likely to tell teachers and the principal of bullying and less likely to tell friends, parents, counselors, siblings, clergy, or police.

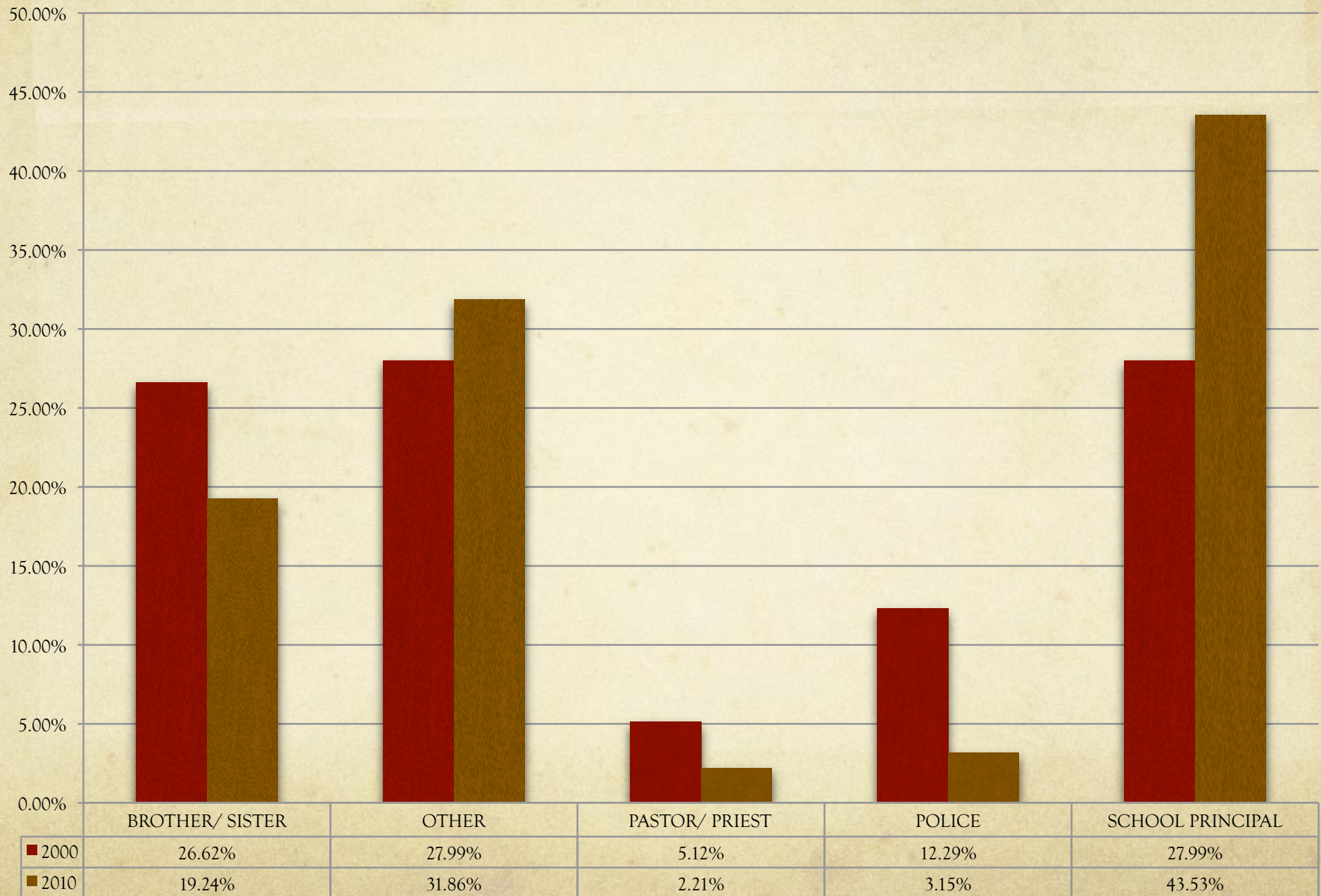


### 31a) Who would you tell if you were being bullied or harassed by another student?

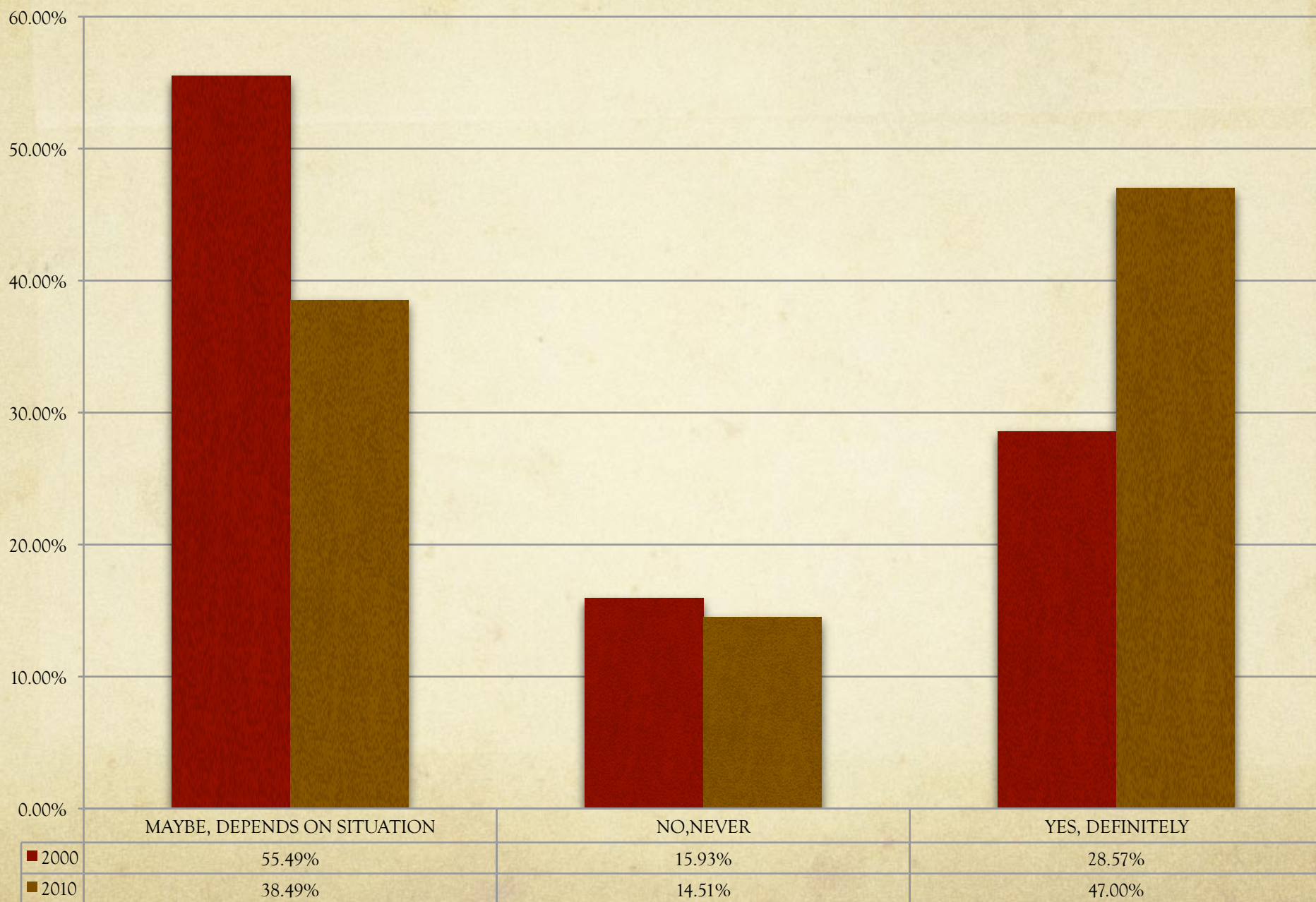


Values on the use of defensive

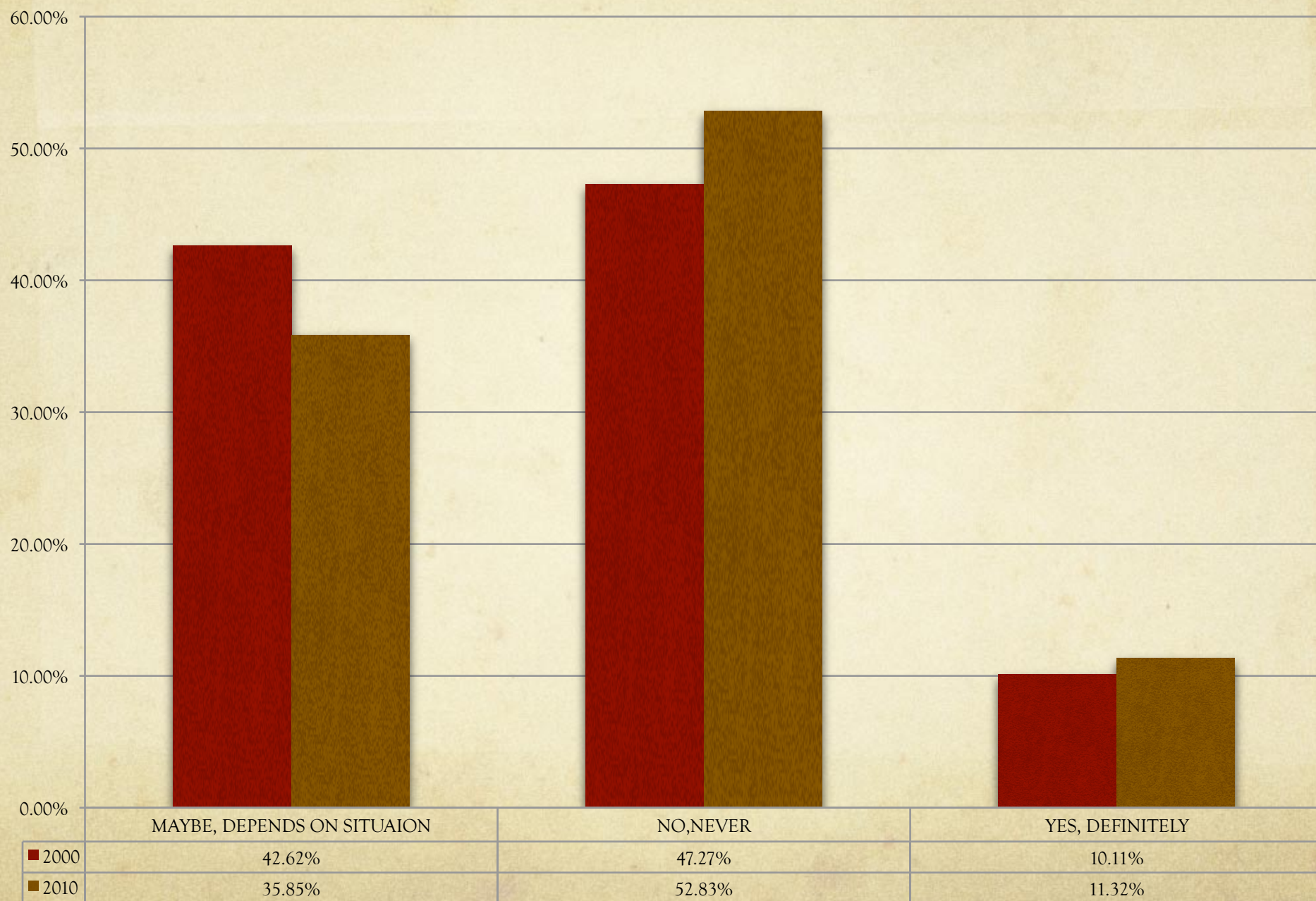

13) Do you believe students have a right to use physical violence to protect themselves from someone hurting his or her feelings or reputation?

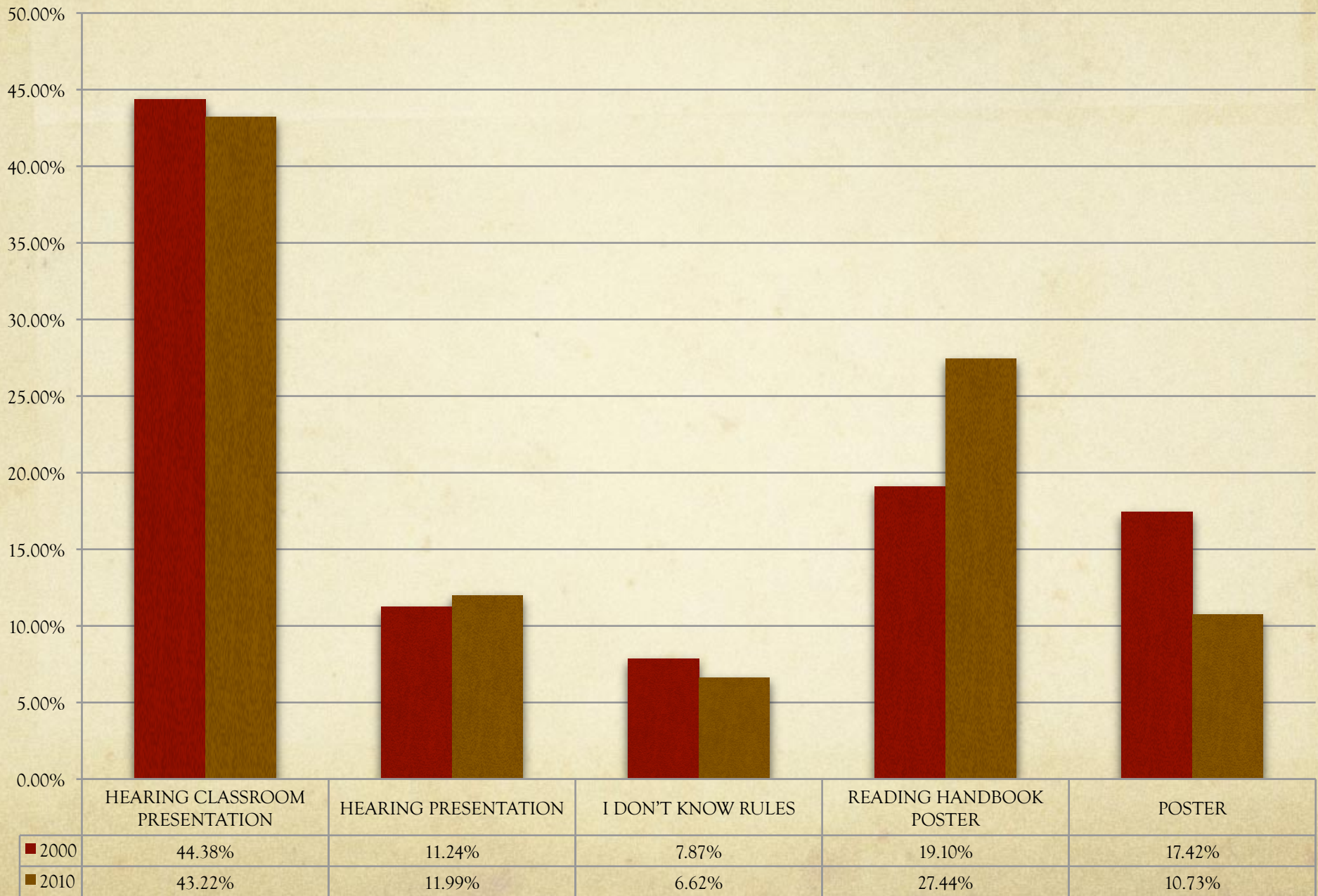




How students gain information
